NOT UNTIL NEEDED.

No Action Taken Regarding Canadian Force For Transvaal.

OTTAWA, Sept. 28.—Despite all rumors of the organization of the Canadian force for South Africa. The Herald correspondent has positively learned that not only has no action been taken but that the question is not a pressing matter of consideration, at the present juncture. Lieut. Col. Sam Hughes has gained some notoriety because of his Quixotic proposal to lead a corps of Canadians to assist the Uitlanders but prominent officials in the Militia Department who are conversant with such matters maintain that Lieut. Col. Hughes must have known from the first that his proposition was not only untenable but one which would leave him liable to prosecution for infringement of the law since, however laudable the object, it has not been considered advisable to leave the disposal of Her Majesty's force at the option of private individuals be they the civilians or militia men. The law has provided a proper machinery for the disposal of the militia forces of Canada and should Her Majesty's Government give its approval and should the Canadian Government, which is responsible, deem it advisable a force can easily, and judging from the enthusiasm which prevails throughout the country can readily be placed at the disposal of the Imperial Government for use in South Africa or in any other part of the Empire where force is necessary for the maintenance of British principles.

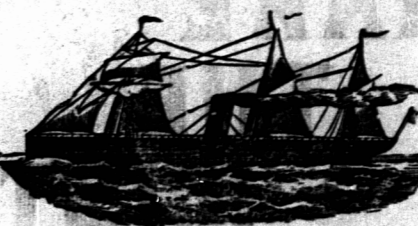
