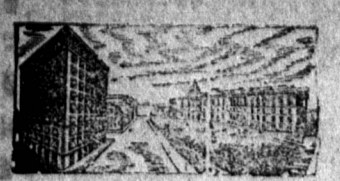

OF SPECIAL INTEREST

LONDON, April 26 (Special)—Major Archer-Shee, M. P., gave emphatic contradiction in the Marconi inquiry to the insinuation that he had or intended to have a financial interest in any wireless enterprise, or that he had ever given utterance to any scandalous tales concerning the action of members of the government. Mr. Charles Granville, who was for a brief period proprietor of the Eye Witness, asserted, that the articles attacking the Ministers which appeared in that journal were inspired by anti-Semitism.

LONDON, April 26 (Special)—Despite the fact that her eloquence probably never was paralleled by a woman, Miss Lind at Hageby, an anti-vice-sectionist leader, who sued Mr. Waldorf Astor's Pall Mall Gazette and Dr. Saleby for alleged libel, yesterday lost her case, the jury returning a verdict for the defendant, with costs.

The case, which has been before the court for sixteen days, during which the plaintiff spoke something like 320,000 words, occupied the jury only a quarter of an hour. The estimated cost of the action is \$65,000.

VALETTA, April 26 (Special)—Cardinal Dominic Ferrata, the Papal Legate to the Eucharistic Congress, which is to be opened here was received with acclamation by vast crowds on the harbor front, and drove through the decorated streets to Floriana, where he was received by the Archbishop of Malta, the foreign dignitaries and the clergy. He subsequently attended a brief service at St. John's Cathedral and drove from there to the Archbishop's palace, where he will reside during the congress.

ST. PETERSBURG, April 26 (Special)—The capture of Sautars has caused great anxiety and activity in diplomatic circles here. The Foreign Minister, Mr. Sazonoff, has been

the family fortune, because the bride was not of noble birth. The guardian of the present duke of Croÿ, then a minor, lodged a complaint on behalf of the Duke as the head of the family and asked that the children be deprived of the princely title, but the Court ruled that it had no jurisdiction in the matter, as the children were French citizens.

MENTONE, April 26 (Special)—Baron Gorell, who was a Judge of the Probate Divorce and Admiralty Division of the English High Court from 1892 to 1905 and president of that court from 1905 to 1909, died here in his sixty-fifth year.

Before being created a baron, in 1909, he was known as Sir John Gorell Barnes, and he probably divorced more persons than any other British Judge.

His son, the Hon. Henry Gorell, who was born in 1882, succeeds to the title. He is a barrister and he obtained part of his education at Harvard University.

LONDON, April 26 (Special)—Protection for the cotton trade of Lancashire by fostering the supply of cotton independent of America was the gist of the argument of the Chancellor, Mr. Lloyd George, on introducing in the House of Commons a resolution permitting the British Government to guarantee a Soudan loan of \$15,000,000 for the development of cotton growing along the Nile.

The Chancellor of the Exchequer remarked that owing to occasional difficulties with regard to supplies of American cotton, arising from the market being cornered and thus creating a shortage here despite abundant crops, it was necessary to foster the growth of cotton where it would be under British control.

The resolution was adopted without division.
