NEW BUILDING IS A GREAT ADDITION TO THE BUSINESS SECTION OF CHARLOTTETOWN

Mr. A. T. MacKinnon Hands Building Over to Trustees Three Months Before Time Specified in Contract.

The new Brace Building which has just been completed is a great addition to the business section of Charlottetown, and an improvement in appearance to that part of Queen Street.

It takes the place of the old

double width building belonging to the late Mr. Brace and occupied by a variety of stores on the ground floor and by residents in the upper flats. The premises were in anything but a satisfactory condition after the destructive fire which oc-

curred there, and the Brace Trustees decided to raze them and erect on the lot a modern up-to-date block of stores and offices. For a short time prior to this the site was occupied by the temporary lunch counter of Mr. William McAllister.

The building, constructed from plans prepared by Mr. James E. Hunter, Architect has a frontage on the east side of Queen St., of sixty feet, and a depth of seventy feet. Three stores are located on the first floor two of which are already rented, the store at the south end of the building to White's Restaurant, and the centre to the Tip Top Store. Several offers have been received for the third store but at present it is still vacant.

There are eight offices on the second floor, one of which is already occupied by Mr. A. J. Haslam, B. A., LL. B. Barrister and Solicitor.

The contract for the building called for its completion by March

31, 1934, but the building will have been handed over to the trustees by the end of December.

One of the most important features of the building is that it has been built and fitted out almost entirely by Island firms. Many of the fixtures which usually are imported were built by the contractor Mr. A. T. MacKinnon at a cost much lower than could have been obtained by patronizing outside firms. The quality of these fittings is as good if not better than the imported articles.

Much credit is due the gentleman who supervised the fittings for having them manufactured on the Island, and Mr. McKinnon deserves credit for the way in which it was done. It is the first time this sort of work has been undertaken here.

UNEMPLOYED TO ENJOY PRIVILEGE OF ART GALLERY
