THE BAPTIST ASSOCIATION.

The Baptists of Prince Edward Island met in their annual association with the church at Cavendish on Friday July 3rd. The day proved all that could be desired. The good people of Cavendish welcomed the delegates to their beautiful new house of worship, and without regard to denomination, in that spirit of whole cordial hospitality, which one meets almost anywhere on this fair Island, and especially in Cavendish. All of the Island Baptist Pastors were present with the exception of Rev. D. P. Nowlan of Dundas who was detained at home by an injured knee. There was also several from Nova Scotia and New Brunswick.

Rev. G. R. White of Charlottetown was elected moderator, Arthur Simpson of Cavendish was re-elected clerk and Ernest W. Spurr, assistant clerk, Deacon A. W. Stearns of Charlottetown was appointed Treasurer. The meetings of Friday morning and afternoon, were devoted to the business of organization and committee reports. In the evening Rev. E. P. Calder gave an instructive address on Christian Service as taught in the Acts, and Rev. G. P. Raymond in his usual clear and impressive manner, showed how to improve the efficiency of our Sunday Schools. Saturday morning Rev. J. C. Spurr gave an excellent digest of the letters from the churches. This exhibit indicated a healthy and hopeful condition. During the year forty-one have been baptized, these with the additions by letter, rather more than counter-balance the losses by death and removal, showing a small net increase.

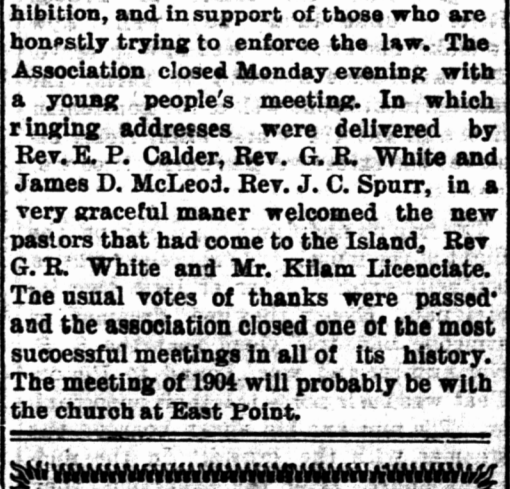
The remainder of the morning session and the afternoon meeting afforded time for reports and discussion which brought out many valuable ideas regarding ways and means for prosecuting christian work. Saturday evening was devoted to the subject of Education, with addresses by Dr. R. V. Jones of Wolfville, Rev. J. C. Spurr, and Rev. F. D. Davidson. Each speaker treated the subject in an interesting manner. The pen pictures of the Presidents of Acadia University by Dr. Jones, was one of the finest displays of word painting that has ever adorned a Prince Edward Island platform.

The beautiful weather of Sunday and the reputation of the speakers, brought together a great throng of the people. At each of the three services the building was overcrowded. The association's sermon was preached in the morning by Rev. E. P. Calder of Summerside. The text being "Send Me" Isa. 6:8. It can only be described as a masterly effort, and among the very best sermons that have been preached before this body.

The afternoon meeting was devoted to missions. Rev. J. W. Manning, D. D. of St. John's, spoke with great earnestness in behalf of Foreign Missions. Miss Martha Clark, missionary to the Telugus, gave a beautiful and eloquent description of her own work among this remarkable people. Rev. A. F. Brown vigorously presented the pressing requirements in connection with Home Mission undertakings. In the evening Rev. G. R. White preached a remarkable sermon. His subject being "The 20th century preacher," founding the discourse on the words "We are laborers together with God," 1st Cor. 3:8. After the sermon an evangelistic meeting was conducted by Rev. J. C. Spurr. A large number took part and quite a number by rising indicated a desire to become christians.

Although many of the visitors returned to their homes after the meeting Sunday evening—all the services of Monday were well attended, the sanctuary being full in the evening. Rev. J. W. Grouler of East Point, presented the circular letter for the Association to the churches, in reply to the letters from the individual churches. This admirable essay on christian duty will be printed in pamphlet form and distributed among the churches to whom it is addressed. In the afternoon the subject of Temperance came up. The report took the form of a vigorous resolution in favor of Prohibition, and in support of those who are honestly trying to enforce the law. The Association closed Monday evening with a young people's meeting. In which ringing addresses were delivered by Rev. E. P. Calder, Rev. G. R. White and James D. McLeod. Rev. J. C. Spurr, in a very graceful manner welcomed the new pastors that had come to the Island, Rev. G. R. White and Mr. Kilan Licentiate. The usual votes of thanks were passed and the association closed one of the most successful meetings in all of its history. The meeting of 1904 will probably be with the church at East Point.
