London Paper Pays Tribute To Canadians... LONDON, Aug. 4.—(CP Cable)—The Evening Standard said today "the Canadians after three weeks under fire have proved themselves worthy comrades and rivals of their fighting kinsmen" (the British 8th Army). In today's editorial, which was completely devoted to a tribute to Canada and the part Canadians are playing in the war, the editorial added: "Already the story of the capture by the Canadians of Agira, which led them to Regalito ranks among the epics of freedom's struggle. The Canadians met the pick of experienced Nazi divisions in difficult, mountainous country and smashed their way into the city through the most formidable defences yet encountered in Sicily."
