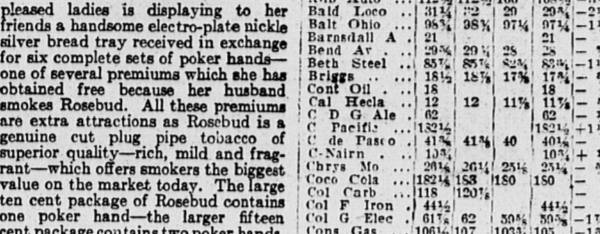
While there was a slight shading off in the prices of government, municipal and public utility bonds at the week-end, this is expected by dealers to be only a temporary situation.
