Livestock

MONTREAL, Sept. 12 (CP)—Trading was slow and prices generally lower in early dealings on Montreal livestock markets today according to the Dominion Department of Agriculture's report.

Early sales of cattle were made up of heifers, cows and common to medium steers, at prices ranging from \$4.50 to \$4.75 for heifers, \$3 to \$4.50 for butcher cows with odd tops at \$4.75, and \$2 to \$2.75 for canners and cutters.

With a liberal offering of sheep and lambs, trading was slow and prices lower. Good ewes and wethers were \$7.75 to \$8. Culls and bucks were cut \$2 per hundredweight. Sheep were from \$2.50 to \$3 with the bulk between \$3 and \$3.50.

Sellers were asking an advance over last week's prices for hogs.

MONTREAL, Sept. 12 (CP)—A large demand for the limited supply of higher grade eggs available sent class "A" large prices soaring another 1-2 cent on the Canadian commodity exchange today.

The cheese market was firm and slightly higher with Ont. white showing a gain of 3-8 at 14-14. Butter futures showed a sharp decline of 1-8 to 3-4.

GRAIN

WINNIPEG, Sept. 12 (CP)—A good export business in Canadian live wheat estimated at 750,000 bushels gave Winnipeg wheat futures a firm undertone late today. Losses of more than a cent were almost eliminated with final quotations 3-8-1-8 cent lower, Oct. 61 5-8, Nov. 61 7-8, Dec. 61 1-2 and May 65 1-8.

Trading was mostly in flurries with offerings outweighing support in the first half of the session and export buying becoming top-heavy near the close.

Traders for the most part waited for the important Nuremberg speech by Chancellor Hitler on the Sudeten German problem.

The cash wheat market remained firm with Nos. 1, 2 and 3 Northern grades at spreads 1-8-1-4 cent improved. It was reported stocks of No. 1 Northern at Port Arthur and Port William have been sold.

Live wheat closed 1-8d higher to 1d lower. Buenos Aires advanced 1-2-3-4 cent at noon and Chicago moved narrowly.

Coarse grain futures generally followed wheat in routine dealings.

Currencies

NEW YORK, Sept. 12 (AP)—The Pound Sterling tumbled 3-4 of a cent in terms of the United States dollar today on the heels of Chancellor Hitler's assertion that Germany is determined to free the Sudeten minority in Czechoslovakia.

The pound, after hesitant efforts to get ahead, closed at the day's low, off 3-4 of a cent at \$4.93-8.

The French franc, checked by control operations, dipped 10-13 of a cent to 2.69 3-4.

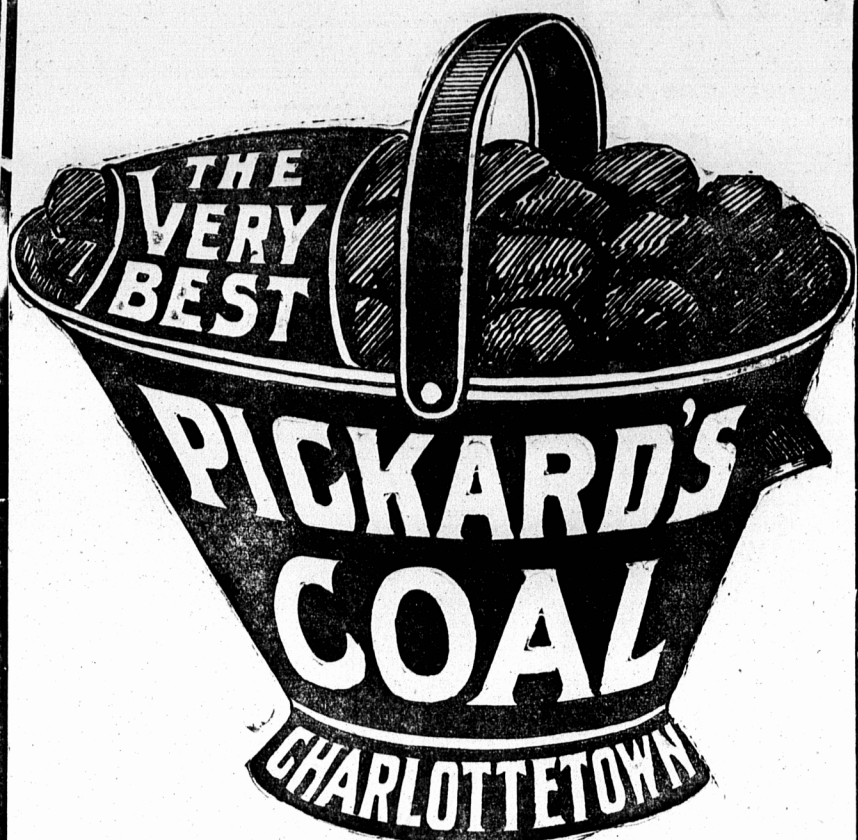
Holland guilders declined 10 of a cent, the Swiss franc .01 of a cent and the belga—at one time ahead in terms of the dollar—dipped .01 of a cent. The Canadian dollar was off 3-16.

MONTREAL, Sept. 12 (CP)—The Pound Sterling advanced 1-16 of a cent to \$4.83 on foreign exchanges here today while the French franc held about even at 2.70-16 cents. The United States dollar advanced 3-16 per cent at 1-2 per cent premium.
