**Stock Markets At A Glance**

**CHICAGO, May 31 — (AP) —** Commission house liquidation and weakness of Winnipeg Rye — at least off as much as three cents — caused a sharp break in grain futures prices today.  
**NEW YORK, May 31 — (AP) —** The Stock Market averages stumbled today after five successive rising sessions to highest levels since 1929.  
 The Associated Press 60-stock composite was off .5 of a point at 98.1.  
**MONTREAL, May 31 — (CP) —** All key groups moved up in indices in trading today on the Stock Exchange and Ourb Market except Industrials, which held at the new seven-year high mark posted on Wednesday. Volume in Industrials was the greatest since September, 1939. Junior miners staged a descent in extension of one cent downward trends. Among individual issues C.P.R. was a feature, rising a major fraction to a new eight-year top during the boarding of 25,575 shares.

**WINNIPEG, May 31 — (CP) —** Giving an erratic display, rye futures in nearby positions dropped as much as four cents at times today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange, when American selling found support thin.  
 Some recoveries were produced near the close of trading and values closed 1 3/8 to 2 3/4 cent lower. May was quoted at \$1.59 5/8-8 and futures finished unchanged.  
**TORONTO, May 31 — (CP) —** The gold stocks trailed the industrial shares to a higher price level today on the Toronto Market, after showing weakness through most of the session. The golds were 20 up. Base Metal and Western Oil issues netted minor declines.  
 The late rally in the golds brought net gains for Amaxco, Aubelle, Central Pacific, Hasaga, Hard Rock, Masada, Kier, New Bidlamague, Pickle Crow, Powell, Rouyn, Springer, Sturgeon, Sylvanite, Wassa Lake and Wright-Hargreaves. Hollinger and Lake Shore had minor losses.
