A sweet brotherly spirit seems to pervade the whole place. We found one poor woman weeping bitterly. She had just received the news of the death of her daughter; and Mr. Bullock stopped and inquired into every detail and most tenderly pitied her. There were parties on the other shore where parings are unknown. While in the office we examined the records and saw that during the past 40 years about 1100 patients had been sheltered there, nearly all of which had embraced Christianity.

In conclusion permit me to thank you all for your many acts of kindness to me since I left home.

Joseph Gedron Horace Bergeron was born at Rigaud on October 18, 1854. He is the son of the late Mr. T. H. Bergeron, notary, residing at Rigaud, County of Vaudreuil, Quebec, and of the late Eudocie Caroline Delphine Coursoil, daughter of Gedeon Coursoil, Esq., notary, of St. Amé, Que. He was educated at the Jesuits, College, Montreal; he also followed a commercial course at the Montreal Business College, where he obtained a diploma. In March, 1877, he graduated a B. C. L. at McGill University. He was called to the Province of Quebec Bar in July, 1877. Mr. Bergeron was first elected to the Commons in January, 1879, through the death of the sitting member, Mr. M. C. J. J. and at the general elections held in 1882 he was re-elected by acclamation, and was also re-elected at the general elections of 1887, 1891 and 1896. He married in July, 1880, Ada Josephine, daughter of the late Mr. H. Wall, of Montreal. In 1888 he was made Chairman of Committee on Standing Orders. In 1891 he was appointed Deputy Speaker and Chairman of Committee of the Commons, and continued so until April, 1896. He is a member of the St. Denis Club, St. Jerome Club, St. James' Club and Le Club Canadien.
