Dalmatin Question Is Not Yet Settled

PARIS, April 23.—Premier Orlando threatens to return to Italy today unless there is a satisfactory adjustment of the Fiume and Dalmatian questions.

Premier Lloyd George of Great Britain is trying to persuade the Italian leader to remain in Paris longer, while he continues his efforts to reconcile the opposing viewpoints. It became known today that Premier Lloyd George tried unsuccessfully during the discussion last night to find a basis for agreement between the differing viewpoints of President Wilson and Premier Orlando on the Italian situation.

The Italian delegation reasserted its determination to stand firm on the question of the Fiume. Indications are that unless the council changed its position the delegation would not return to the conference. An early settlement of the difficulty is consequently thought to be impossible.
