Some of our Sunday School chums from the coasts of Nova Scotia or Newfoundland or British Columbia would be able to describe the scenes and circumstances of this lesson with all the thrilling interest of those who have knowledge of the moods of the sea under the fickle play and power of the wind. Other lessons have gripped the attention of the scholars in the cities as the special features of such great centres of popular as Antioch and Athens and Corinth and Ephesus were told; but this time the scholar by the sea has his innings.

At the same time we are to learn that the man who was master of the situation during this remarkable voyage from Caesarea to Rome was not the sailor, but the prisoner. When he first made his suggestion it was passed over as of small value. What did he know about the ways of the wind or the sailing of ships of the value of harbors? Of course the captain knew a great deal more. That's what the centurion and the soldiers thought, and without a doubt, the owner of the vessel and the crew were of the same mind. But after a long time—weeks indeed—they saw that Paul had been right, and they readily submitted to his leadership. His manhood, his sagacity, his remarkable foresight brought him to the front.

Besides, there was a nameless something which kept him up when others broke down. And it was not his physical fitness. He was far from being a well man. Why, after the very first any cut, when the boat landed at Sidon, he needed bodily refreshment. No, his fitness was of a moral and spiritual kind. He believed God, and he grasped in some large and sure way what God's purpose was, and let all other circumstances to it, regardless to their untoward appearance, and in the strength it gave him he was able to keep up where others went to pieces, and to command where others lost control.

Synopsis of Canadian North West Land Regulations.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Land Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Agency, on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

Duties.—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a section of at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section along side his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties. Must reside six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra.

A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may take a purchased non-resident in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$3000.00.
