THE COST OF THE SESSION.

Some of the able editors have figured out the cost of keeping Parliament in session at \$24,000 a day. This is intended as an argument against prolonging the sessions. But the fact is that the pay of the Members of Parliament is the same whether the sessions are long or short, and amounts to nearly \$750,000. The same is true of the salaries of the permanent staff of officials, clerks, messengers and doorkeepers. The cost of a long session over a short one is, however, a very material thing to Senators and Members themselves, but the country will waste little sympathy upon them, remembering the salary grab by which they recouped themselves in advance.

The cost of legislation at Ottawa during the first five years after confederation was in round figures about \$400,000 a year. In 1903-4 it reached \$1,266,795; the following year it was \$1,713,172 and in the short fiscal year 1906-7 it was \$1,322,074. The present longer session will, of course cost more, running well up to the two million mark. So the pay of Members and Senators which was about \$150,000 a year in the beginning of things federal in Canada is now

practically five times as much, and the cost of legislation four times as much as it was then, or more. The additional cost is very largely the increased pay of members, officials and attendants and the expenditure on Hansard, which was not in existence in the earlier years of the Dominion.

No one would desire to send an irresponsible man to the gallows, but there is another extreme also to be avoided by making the way of escape easy for the slayer of his fellowman. Men who contemplate bloody deeds will become bold to act if the fear of punishment is taken away.

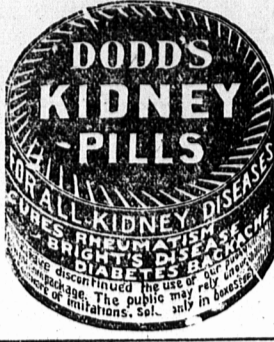

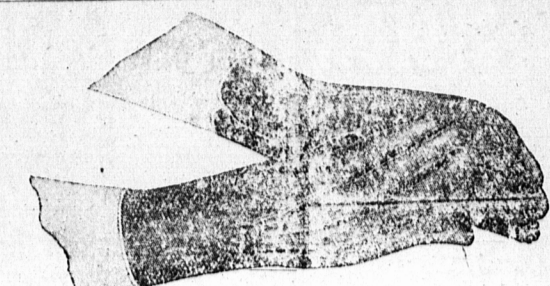
