MCGILL CHARGED WITH STEALING

Over a Million The Property of The Failed Ontario Bank.

TORONTO, Dec. 5.—At the conclusion of a brief sitting in the palace court today a third charge was laid against Charles McGill of stealing \$1,150,000, the property of the Ontario Bank.

Magistrate Denison announced he would accept McGill's own surety in \$100,000 on this new charge, the bail of \$50,000 on the other two charges being renewed by his bondsmen.
