(Associated Press) BARENTSBURO, Green Harbor, Spitzbergen, Aug. 29.—Travelers who imagine Spitzbergen to be inhabited by a few rough trappers and seal-hunters, living on raw walrus blubber in wretched hovels, are greatly surprised at the comforts and luxuries enjoyed at the few visitors who lack the comforts of Barentsburg, Longyear City and Ny Alesund.

These local headquarters of the different coal companies are veritable havens of refuge to the officers, administration buildings, with double doors and windows, music and billiard rooms, a well-stocked library, priceless furs on polished floors and old Dutch masters on the walls. Director Dresselhuys' far northern home appears as if it might have been bodily transplanted from the finest residential quarters of The Hague or Amsterdam.

POLICE OF ULSTER AND FREE STATE UNITE IN RAID ON MOONSHINERS

BELFAST, Aug. 20.—Moonshiners in the south of Ulster have lost the protection which formerly was accorded them by the border line, across which they used to fit when hard pressed on one side or the other.

The Ulster constabulary under command of Inspector Robinson, and the Monaghan Civil Guards, under Chief Superintendent Murphy, recently carried out a joint raid on an 18-mile front. It was the first time the rival police forces have cooperated in such a manner. Together they carried out their activities for eight hours and thoroughly routed the stills.
