West's heart overall was the sort of bid that most players seem unable to resist making, but which requires a minor miracle for success. True, West was in no great danger at one heart in view of his extreme suit length, but by the same token the possible gain from making the bid was highly dubious. Even if West found a heart fit, it was not to be hoped that with only one king, a blank queen, and a jack in the West hand, a partner who had passed originally would be able to supply enough cards to outbid the opponents.

However, West's real error was not his overcall, but his opening lead against the doubled five-diamond contract. Surely, West should have felt that the situation, very pretty black, since East must have counted on him for more than he was going to produce. Thus, West's actual selection of a heart had little to recommend it. He should have led his singleton queen of clubs, in the desperate hope of finding East with the ace and getting a ruff.

Obviously, a club ruff would have defeated the contract, since East had a sure trump trick. On the heart lead, however, South had little difficulty in handling his problem, and after he had drawn West's one trump, all he had to do was lead a club from dummy and when East ducked, go right up with the king. (East was marked with the club ace for his double.)
