Summerside and Prince County News.

Mrs. Stephen Schurman who has been visiting her sister, Mrs. John Dickieson and other relatives on the Island leaves by the Stanley this morning on return to her home in Terrela, Texas.

Rev. J. M. Withycombe and family leave by the Stanley this morning for Windsor, N. S. where they will visit friends previous to proceeding to their future home in Cleveland, Ohio.

Rev. W. H. Smith was on Xmas eve presented with a handsome overcoat by the ladies of his congregation. The coat is muskrat lined Melton with a \$5 otter collar. The presentation was made informally and no doubt the gift is duly appreciated.

For some reason not very satisfactorily explained the Stanley did not leave the Harbor yesterday morning. The very successful round trip made on the previous day proved to the entire satisfaction of all interested that under present conditions two round trips daily could easily be made if necessary and the fact that the steamer was allowed to lie idle yesterday in the mildest of weather with a large quantity of freight and a number of passengers waiting for her has given rise to a good deal of pretty severe criticism and much disappointment. She is however advertised to leave this morning at 8 o'clock for Cape Tormentine.

A MEETING of the Council of the Summerside Board of Trade was held yesterday morning in the office of the town clerk. The president, Mr. R. C. McLeod, explained that in view of the favorable circumstances connected the Stanley's experimental trip to Cape Tormentine on Xmas Day establishing almost beyond doubt the fact that daily communication can be maintained on this route under ordinary winter conditions, it is most desirable that such repairs be made to Cape Tormentine pier as will facilitate the landing of passengers and freight as well as insure of the safety of the steamer while lying there. He also recommended that steps be taken to induce the department to transfer the mails to this route so as to remedy the present most unsatisfactory mail service by which as has happened during the past week several days elapsed without a mail being received from abroad. A committee was appointed to communicate with Sir L. H. Davies and telegrams in accordance with the president's suggestions were forwarded.

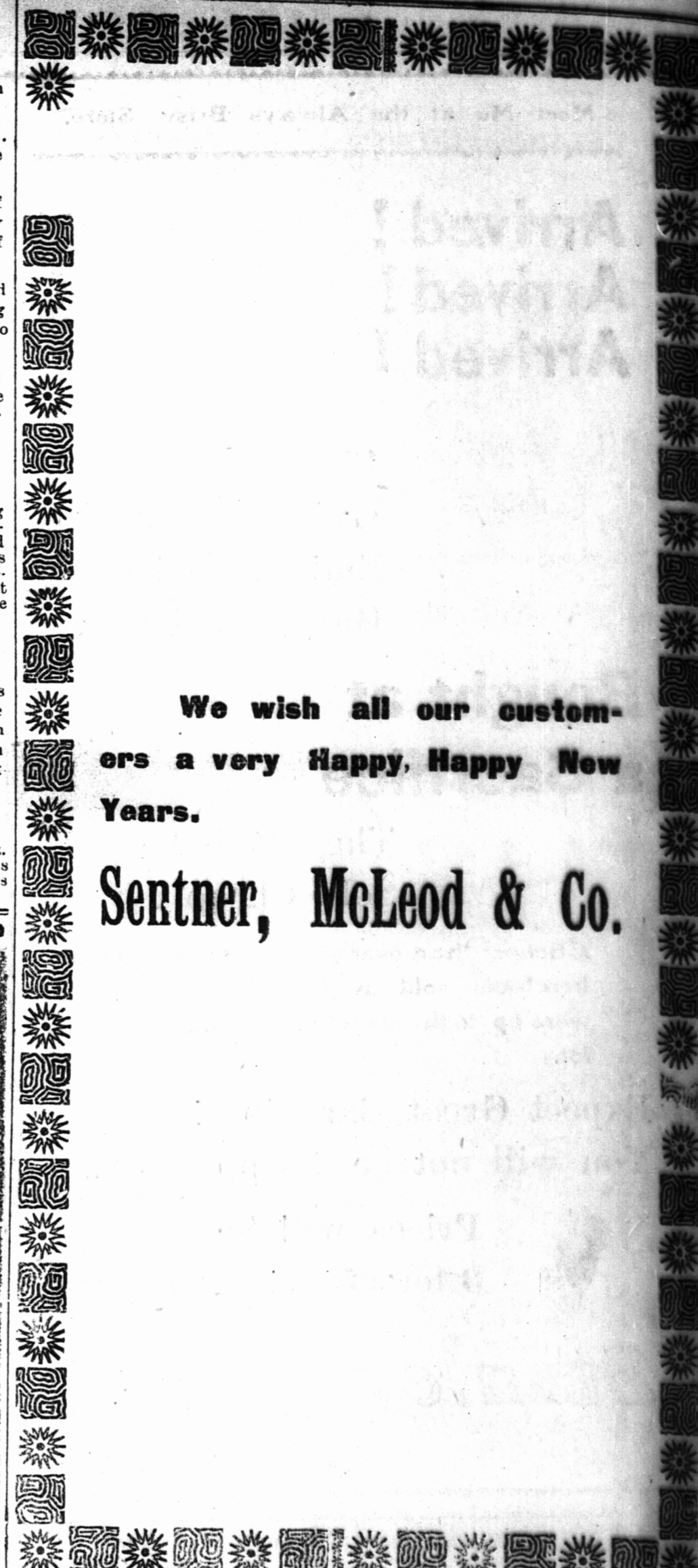
