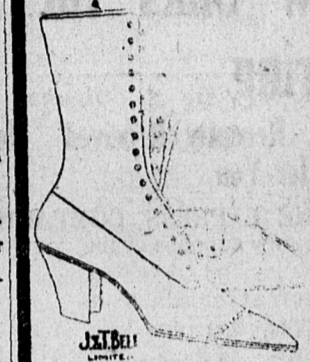

Referendum on Prohibition

TORONTO, March, 8.—Hon. T. W. McGarry, Provincial Treasurer, speaking at a meeting of Ward 3 Conservative Association at St. George's Hall last night, said "A wide open referendum on the prohibition question will be taken in Ontario, possibly in September next, or possibly sooner, for the people to determine what measure they want." "I believe," he said "the people should be able to vote on the question in a very open fashion, when the boys come home, possibly in September or before, or it may be a little later. Then the people will decide the question for themselves, and the referendum will be wide open as is desired by the Provincial people and the liquor interests. Whatever the verdict of the people may be, the Government will uphold it."

Fur Market Steady

(Special to The Guardian) NEW YORK, Mar. 11.—Two things stand out in the local fur market at the moment: one is the firmness with which the prices of all kinds of furs is held and the other is the unprecedented demand from the retail trade for spring and summer furs that is reported by the manufacturers. According to the market report of the New York fur auction sales corporation the call for Russian sable, squirrel, mink, blue fox, cross fox and silver fox is especially good, these being furs that lend themselves well to this class of trade. At the same time more active business in beaver, house cat, muskrat, opossum and skunk, is in evidence. Prices generally are strongly supported at mid-winter levels, one of the chief factors in this situation being the shortage of many kinds of foreign furs in this market. This, taken in conjunction with the demand now current is said by the report to preclude any marked drop in price in the future. With these conditions prevailing the corporation anticipates that present market prices on substantially all kinds of furs will be more than sustained at the spring auction which begins on April 7th.
