AHOY! ABOARD THE MOTOR BOATS

Apparently this Province has one thoroughly representative motorboatman in New York. I notice by the last issue of Motor Boating that Whittelsey & Whittelsey of New York, who are among the biggest naval architects in America, have designed a ninety-foot vessel of the most modern type for Bruce McKelvie, formerly of Summerside, and drawings of the boat accompany the description. The vessel is under construction at the yards of the Hudson Yacht and Boat Company of Nyack, N. Y. She is 30 x 15 and the raised deck type of construction has been used with a break in the sheer slightly abaft the middle body, so that seaworthiness is provided and the general appearance of the craft is considerably beautified. This break in the sheer line has been so arranged that side windows may be used in every stateroom, thus providing an unusual accommodation. The entire raised deck section is utilized as well as the main deck, and the bridge deck is located abaft the deck house, where the vessel may be hauled with the greatest ease. Aft of the bridge is the funnel into which the engine will exhaust. The stern is of the overhanging transom yacht type with a flat underbody and the draft has been limited to four feet. The entire finish of the interior is to be of polished African mahogany in the owner's quarters, with white bulkheads and side panels and the engine room, crew's quarters, etc., will be finished in Carolina pine which will be electrically lighted, and will have two 98-h. p. Sterling motors. She is expected to have a speed of 15 1/2 miles per hour. This is something of a boat and she will no doubt put in an appearance here sometime during the coming summer. Mr. McKelvie is well known in this port and his friends will be glad to see him with his new motor yacht.

The opening of navigation in Charlottetown has now been brought about, through the good work of the Minto, and there seems to be a desire among the "motor bugs" to be up and doing. What a blessing that there are no "sea horses" on our water ways to put us to the trouble of having an act passed by the Legislature to allow us to run motor boats. If such were the case what a terrible time some of the boatmen would have. There are some of them who can make noise enough to wake a mummy, and there are some that leave behind them a trail of perfume that has the skunk market looking weak. Both offenders in such cases should be made to install silencers, which are splendid devices to overcome noise and stink. Fortunately the highway of the sea is free to all; and, after all, variety is the spice of life so we may expect to have our eyes gratified and our noses assaulted as usual when the boats take to the water again.

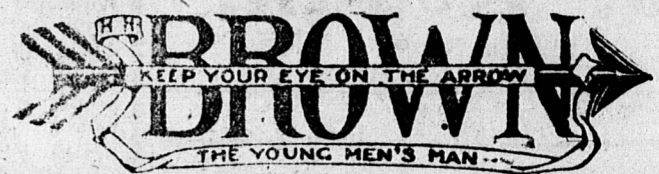

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH WEST LAND REGULATIONS.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, may homestead a quarter section of a valuable Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Subagency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Agency, on certain conditions by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

Duties.—Six months' residence upon the homestead or pre-emption six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to erect homestead improvements) and cultivate 10 acres extra.

A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead tract and cannot obtain pre-emption may enter for a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$200 p. r. acre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$200.
