A GREAT SINGER'S LITTLE ROMANCE

BERLIN, Dec. 11 (Special)—With the death of the once famous prima donna Fraulein Josephine Schefsky at Munich the secret has been revealed, after being religiously preserved for 40 years, why the great singer so suddenly fell into disgrace in 1879, and was practically compelled to leave Munich to sing at the opera houses at Nuremberg, Karlsruhe, and Berlin. The disgrace came from the whim of two people, one of whom was the opera singer herself and the other Louis II., King of Bavaria.

The singer found to her cost, however, that opera singing and comedy are two very different arts. Not only did the King notice at once that the spot where the half-submerged prima donna was appealing for help was one of absolutely no danger, but he also saw through the meaning of the by-play. Turning to his secretary he said: "What a pity that such an artist cannot put a play on better than that!" and then sent an eueury to the diva and her "rescuer" to tell them of his displeasure.

ATHENS, Dec. 10 (Special)—Greece has issued provisional stamps for Lemnos, Imbro, Samothrace and Thasos—the Islands restored by her fleet to the Athenian Empire after two thousand years. As these stamps will be withdrawn on the conclusion of the war many of the philatelic brotherhood will have to be content with the commemorative stamp at present being printed, representing Olympus, and on the summit an eagle killing a serpent.

BERLIN, Dec. 10 (Special)—It has at last been decided that the German Emperor shall have a new yacht. The Hohenzollern, really a cruiser, whose dazzling white hull has long been a familiar sight to tourists in the Norwegian fjords, and which has also been seen on occasion by visitors to Corfu, but more frequently by visitors to the Kiel Regatta, is pronounced to be technically unsafe.

She was built at Stein in 1892, but according to the German experts who have examined her in the light of the revelations of the Titanic disaster, she fails to fulfill modern requirements as regards safety. Nevertheless, it will be three years before the new vessel which is to take her place will be ready for commission. A vote of \$1,250,000 for the new yacht is to be included in the Estimates for next year. The designs are understood to be still under discussion, and it is not known whether the new vessel is to be a royal yacht similar to those which carry the King of England, the Czar, and the King of Spain to sea, or whether, as is considered more likely, it shall be as the Hohenzollern today, a fighting unit, symbolizing the constant and inseparable connection between the Emperor and the military forces of the German Empire.
