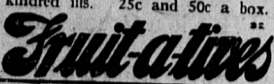


To the Moon In A Rocket

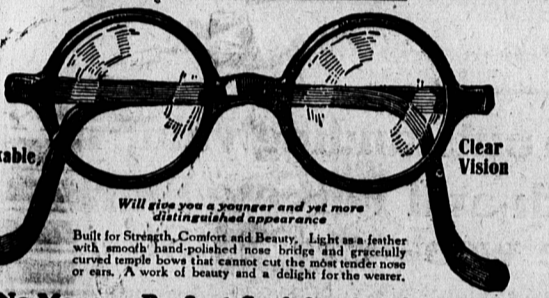

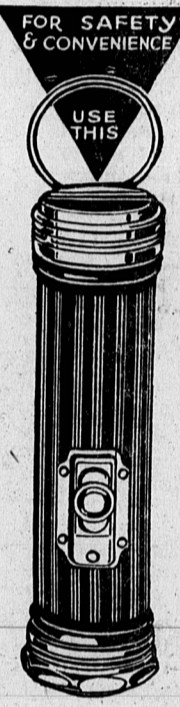
