Stock Markets At A Glance

LONDON, Nov. 22 (CP)—The Stock Market closed generally steady today with traders showing a selective attitude. Turnover was moderate.

WINNIPEG, Nov. 22 (CP)—United Kingdom interests purchased 500,000 bushels of Canadian wheat today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange in a moderately active session.

CHICAGO, Nov. 22 (CP)—Grain Markets gave up fractions of their early advance shortly before noon today but, after profit taking had run its course, quickly rallied, some reaching new highs for the session.

TORONTO, Nov. 22 (CP)—Gold issues were up in the early stage on the Toronto Exchange today but they failed to hold through the late selling and the index for the group was down .43 at the close.

NEW YORK, Nov. 22 (AP)—Selling encountered on an opening advance gave today's Stock Market an irregular appearance which varied but little the rest of the session.

MONTREAL, Nov. 22 (CP)—A number of leaders worked into higher ground in trading today on the Stock Exchange and Curb Market but there was a roodly sprinkling of easier issues in the list headed as well. Industrials, utilities and golds were higher in the indices and generally, despite strength in one area, and bats were down.
