This machine is designed for target practice without the use of ammunition, the elimination of which removes the element of danger attending range shooting and also reduces the expense.

The degree of accuracy or inaccuracy of aim is recorded by the scoring needle, which is so adjusted as to reproduce in a magnified degree every movement of the rifle in the hands of the marksman.

Those in charge will be glad to show and explain the working of same to any persons wishing to see it.

Use one may become a proficient marksman, and is afforded a means of retaining such frequent practice with the machine. At the time when, as never before, armies are equipped with such high power rifles, and good marksmanship is of the utmost importance, No. 3 is particularly lucky in having acquired one of those sub-target gun machines especially as it is the first one in operation on the island and one of the first in Canada.
