—ISLAND LADY DEAD.—The death occurred in Winnipeg, Manitoba, on Dec. 7th, of Mrs. G. B. Murchison, formerly Miss Mildred Newcome, daughter of Mrs. Lewis Leard, Summerside. The deceased had been sick only a few months and leaves to mourn three children.
