

### Tot and Dentist Getting Together

CHICAGO, Oct. 22 — (AP) — They're fixing things now so Junior won't fear the dentist—and the dentist won't fear Junior, either. In the comparatively new, but growing field of pedodontics—dentistry for children—psychology is being used to put youngsters at ease. And specialized training is being given to put practitioners in the same happy state.

A new graduate course in this specialty at the University of Illinois College of Dentistry, includes instruction in the fine art of child management. The procedures recommended require knowledge and finesse, but they are quite simple.

A pedodontist takes his first cue from the patient. He determines the level of the child's emotional and mental developments, and speaks the child's language. He'll talk with a four-year-old about things very close to the tooth—his mother, toy trains, picture books.

But conversation with an athletic kid of 10 will turn to baseball football or basketball. A few leading questions—such as "What position do you play on the team?"—should loosen the boy's tongue. And the more he practices, the less timid he becomes.

A teen-ager is treated as an adult. The best approach is to ascertain his hobby—building radio sets, perhaps—and chat about that, even at the expense of reaping up on the subject after office hours.

is never to do any painful work on a child during his first visit except in an emergency. This overcomes the contagious fright he picked up from playmates or parents.

The dentist never should lie. If it's going to hurt, he should say: "This will bother you for a moment." The child appreciates this honesty, and has full faith in the dentist thereafter.

A soft voice inspires confidence. Subdued radio music helps, too. A habit of making suggestions, instead of giving orders, makes Operation Molar a co-operative project. Color and equipment enter into the scheme of things, too. An office decorated in yellows and gay greens, and brightly illumined by a shade of light, is warm and cheerful.

That old bugbear, the drill, should be unobtrusive—set on a low stand instead of hanging overhead, like a damoclean sword. A bubbling fountain, instead of a cup, pleases the younger set.

### Is Acquitted In Spy Trial

OTTAWA, Oct. 22 — (CP) — Eric George Adams, a slender, studious man with a library of 2,000 books, was acquitted today by an Ontario Supreme Court jury that deliberated nearly four hours before deciding that he had not conspired to communicate confidential information to Russia.

The acquittal of the 39-year-old former official of several government financial branches was the second within a week of persons named in the report of the royal commission on espionage. Five others have been convicted or have pleaded guilty in Canada and a sixth was found guilty in England.

A big grin on his face, the Hull, Que., native told reporters he hoped to return to his work with the industrial development Bank in Montreal, a subsidiary of the Bank of Canada. He still is on the roster of employees, although his salary was stopped in August.

Meanwhile, bail of \$5,000 was continued while the Crown considers its next step in connection with two other charges against Adams, one of communicating information to Russia and the other of retaining government documents. Both are alleged breaches of the Official Secrets Act.

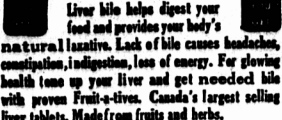

### Approves Boost In Western Coal Prices

OTTAWA, Oct. 22 — (CP) — Increases of western coal prices varying to consumers from 60 cents to \$1.50 a ton, were announced tonight by the Prices Board.

The price increase followed approval by the National War Labor board of a new contract between mine operators and the United Mine Workers (C.M.W.), providing for wage increases.

Increased cost of western bituminous coal to railways and industrial users will amount to 85 cents a ton. General average increase at the mine will be \$1 a ton with the exception of Vancouver Island where the increase will be \$1.50.

### Motor Tourist Bureaus Insists Argentina Oust Nazi Agents at Border Points

OTTAWA, Oct. 22 — (CP) — Establishment of motor tourist bureaus at border points is being considered, Revenue Minister McCreagh told a dinner meeting of the conference of Dominion and Provincial travel officials.

Provision of adequate landing fields and modern customs facilities for air travellers also was being studied by government officials.

"We do not propose to be as far behind relatively in meeting the increase in air travel as we were for the similar rapid expansion of motor traffic," he said.

Fisheries Minister Bridges said the fisheries department was being reorganized. Of some 100 inspectors to be appointed in the Maritimes and British Columbia — only provinces over which the Dominion Department has jurisdiction — about one-third would have control over angling streams. Their work would help the tourist industry.

### Threaten Mine War On British

JERUSALEM, Oct. 22 — (CP) — The Stern Gang's second manifesto in 48 hours tonight threatened a "drastic intensification of the mine war against the British."

The proclamation said more and more mines would be placed in the path of military vehicles. Leaflets scattered by the underground Jewish resistance organization last night threatened shooting for all British officers carrying guns.

The new manifesto said the gang was responsible for the blasting of two railway engines near Jerusalem Monday night.

Meanwhile, two shiploads of Jews, many of them former prisoners in German concentration camps, sailed for Cyprus from Haifa, after being stopped short of Palestine. The 814 would-be immigrants, who lacked legal entry papers, were intercepted yesterday after two weeks' voyage in the little schooner Fenice.

### FLOODIT MOUNTAIN

CAPETOWN — (CP) — South Africa's famous Table Mountain is to be flooded for the royal visit of King George VI next February. It will be the first time such a spectacular project has been attempted here. Technicians of the Union of South Africa defence force already have selected sites for gigantic searchlights to focus on the mountain which rises behind Capetown harbor.

**Vital Statistics For August Released**

HALIFAX, Oct. 22 — (CP) — Increases in births and deaths and a decline in the number of marriages during August were reported tonight by the Provincial Health Department in a monthly survey of vital statistics in Nova Scotia's five largest centres.

Totals from Halifax, Sydney, Glace Bay, Dartmouth and Truro were: 881 births, 175 deaths and 348 marriages in August compared with 546 births, 153 deaths and 359 marriages the same month last year.

Vital statistics for August with figures for August, 1945, in brackets:

Births: Halifax 363 (305), Sydney 135 (93), Glace Bay 116 (84), Truro 64 (60), Dartmouth 3 (4).

Deaths: Halifax 95 (87), Sydney 38 (29), Glace Bay 22 (32), Truro 17 (3), Dartmouth 3 (2).

Marriages: Halifax 184 (201), Sydney 79 (68), Glace Bay 38 (41), Truro 33 (32), Dartmouth 14 (17).

**Clean-Up Garden Control Insects**

Despite the recent introduction of several new and valuable insecticides such as DDT, benzene hexachloride (666), and others, the cleaning up of gardens at this season of the year to reduce the numbers of insects going into hibernation is just as valuable and necessary as it ever was, says Alan G. Duxson, Division of Entomology, Dominion Department of Agriculture.

With the approach of winter many species of insects seek cover in any convenient shelter within and outside the garden such as on standing crop refuse, beneath piles of rubbish, in matted grass or headlands, along fence rows and generally in waste lands where protection from the weather of the weather is naturally provided. Such places of concealment should be removed and destroyed by burning or burying before winter sets in.

This practice at once removes potential pests which otherwise will emerge next spring to threaten the new crops.

Where possible, fall ploughing should be done. Dead and dying vegetation should be raked up and burned. Stands of weeds in nearby wastelands should be scythed and destroyed or better still, the whole area should be burned over under supervision, so that the fire will not get beyond control. Cocoons should be scraped from fences, buildings and shrubbery and egg-masses of insects where present cut from trees and bushes and destroyed. In other words a complete clean up campaign should be carefully planned and carried out in and around every garden. October is a suitable month for such work.
