INCREASED COST OF LIVING IN ENGLAND.  
LONDON, June 14—Figures issued today by the metropolitan asylum's board show increases in the cost of food as compared with last year as follows: Bacon, 16 per cent.; cheese, 10 per cent.; bread, 8 per cent.; butter, 13 per cent.; cocoa, 30 per cent.; flour, 10 per cent.; rice, 15 per cent.; and sugar, 20 per cent.

**DOCTOR GETS DAMAGES.**  
LONDON, June 15—A libel suit of considerable interest to the medical profession has just ended before the Lord chief justice, the jury awarding to Robert Bell, a well-known Mayfair doctor, \$10,000 damages against Dr. Bashford, general superintendent and director of the laboratories of the imperial cancer research fund, and the British Medical Journal, which published an article written by Dr. Bashford, entitled, "Cancer, Credulity and Quackery," also an editorial note, wherein the plaintiff complained he was accused of being a quack, and an imposter, preying on the credulity of the public in connection with his treatment of cancer by methods other than by a surgical operation.
