**IRISH CHILD IS MARKED  
WITH SYMBOLS  
OF THE PASSION.**

LONDON, Nov. 26.—The Mayo News publishes an account of a child in Kiltamagh Convent, who is marked with the symbols of the Passion. It says:—

"A girl aged 13, so the story goes, has been a boarder in the convent for the past three or four years. She is described as a docile, affectionate child and is a great favorite with the nuns.

"About three weeks ago one of the sisters heard the child screaming during the night, and when she questioned her the girl told her she had had a fearful dream, in which she saw Christ on the cross and a soldier driving a lance into his side. The nun comforted the child, who fell asleep.

"In the morning the child complained that her wrist and arms were sore. On examination it was found that her forearm was marked with a cross in red. Underneath the cross were the letters 'I. H. S.'

"A few days later there appeared below the letters a crown of thorns. Two or three days later there appeared above the cross letters surrounded by a scroll.

"A few days subsequently there appeared beneath the crown of thorns a chalice surmounted by a Host, sending forth rays in red; and after the same period there appeared a flower-shaped drawing, near which was written the word 'Lily.'

"The marks extend from the wrist to the upper arm, and have been examined by Father O'Hara, P. P., Kiltamagh, Dr. Maden, Kiltamagh, and very many others.

"A remarkable feature of the occurrence is that at 3 p. m., on Friday the stigmata bled copiously. A careful inquiry is being instituted by the religious authorities, who, while admitting the strikingly wonderful nature of the phenomena, refrain from any expression of opinion as to its origin.

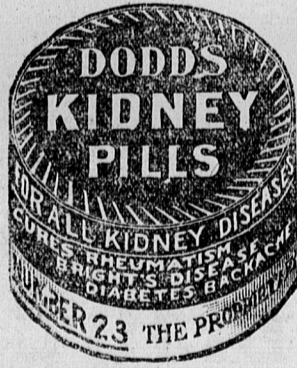
"Dr. Maden and others who have seen the marks are quite positive that they were not self-inflicted."

**BRAKEMAN CHARGED  
WITH THEFT \$20,000**

TORONTO, Nov. 30.—A warrant was issued today by attorney-general's department for the apprehension of Edward Elmer McIntosh, a railway brakeman, who is charged with the theft of a package of \$20,000 unsigned Traders' bank bills, consigned from the American Bank Note company, Ottawa, to Teachers' Bank Toronto. In March last year notes were in the care of the Dominion Express company and while suspicion was directed against McIntosh at the time of the robbery, nothing could be brought against him, altho shortly after the occurrence he was discharged by the railway company. Ever since the robbery, McIntosh has been under watch. Six thousand dollars of the missing money was found by a small boy while playing at a grate in McIntosh's former home, and the remaining \$14,000 was discovered in a trunk owned by McIntosh. From the office of Superintendent Rogers, of the provincial police, the following description of the missing man was issued. Edward McIntosh, height 5 feet six inches; weight 160 pounds, age 25 years; brown hair, full face, clean shaven, fair complexion, straight nose, prominent dimple in chin, he was formerly employed as railway brakeman.

**ELECTION RUMOR.**

OTTAWA, Dec. 2.—There is a persistent rumor current that the Government has determined to appeal to the country next autumn, and with this in view, that Laurier has abandoned his proposed visit to London for the Coronation; and soon as Parliament rises, next May, will devote himself to a tour of Quebec, the Maritime Provinces and Western Ontario, where he will seek to educate the people on the Naval Question.

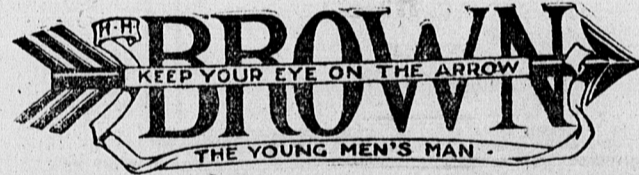

**IN ENGLISH POLITICS.**

LONDON, Dec. 2.—There is a possibility of an unlooked for result in attempt of Mr. Balfour to remove Tariff Reform from the immediate field of politics.

The question looks larger than ever in the campaign inasmuch as Mr. Balfour himself, at reading, was fain to explain that his party had not altered its views on the subject, and that Tariff Reform was still a chief plank in party construction policy. But he explained that the Unionists needed to obtain the formal and explicit consent of the people thereon. The policy of a Referendum, he said, was consistent with the true idea of a popular government.

Mr. Balfour's pronouncement that he was willing to submit Tariff Reform to referendum has rather surprised than knit his party and supplied the Liberals with another effective argument against Tariff Reform namely, that Mr. Balfour has been compelled to side track it.

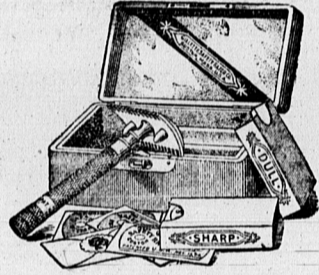
