THE PASTEURIZATION ORDINANCE

As the pasteurization of milk is a much discussed question in many parts and cities of Canada at the present time, the following article from the New York Produce Review is timely, and may prove interesting to our people.—Secretary, National Dairy Council of Canada.)

That milk is a natural food and therefore, needs no processing to make it more valuable for human consumption. Scientists, however, are in quite general accord that from a purely physical standpoint proper pasteurization renders milk more easily digested and of greater general benefit to the human race.
