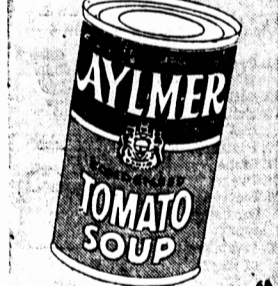

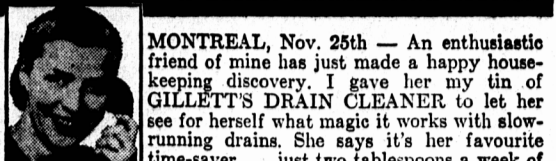

### MacEwen Orange Lodge Celebrate

On Friday evening, Nov. 5, upwards of seventy members of MacEwen Orange Lodge, their wives and friends assembled in their lodge room, Pinetie, Belfast to celebrate Guy Fawkes day, known as the gunpowder plot in the House of Lords, Great Britain, also a joint memorial service in memory of the deceased members of the lodge who have passed away since this lodge was founded. This being the 25th anniversary of MacEwen Lodge, Bro. Daniel Ross, a past master of the lodge, capably acted as chairman and invited the guests of honor for the evening to the platform who were the Rev. Dr. R.S. Quigley of St. John's Presbyterian Church, Belfast, also a brother Orangetan and Brother G.D. MacPhail of Cornwall. Most Worshipful Grand Master of the Grand Orange Lodge of Prince Edward Island. The program opened when all joined in singing "O Canada" with Mrs. Mabel MacEachern as organist.

A very appropriate and instructive address was given by the Rev. Dr. Quigley on the gunpowder plot of Nov. 5, 1605 who thoroughly explained its origin and purpose. Brother MacPhail, the next speaker, told of the work of the Orange Lodge and the Loyal Orange Benevolent Association, and paid tribute to the faithful

members of the lodge who have passed into a higher lodge above. The names of the deceased members were then read by the secretary, Brother George Docherty and included the Rev. Dr. W.H. MacEwen, who was Grand Master of the Grand Orange Lodge, P.E.I. at the time MacEwen Lodge was organized, also the Rev. J.W. MacKenzie, Minister of St. John's Presbyterian Church, Belfast, at the time. In all there were fourteen names read. A one minute silence was then observed followed with prayer by the Rev. Dr. Quigley.

Next on the program was a splendid address by Brother Donald McKinnon M.L.A. who spoke on the work and fellowship of the

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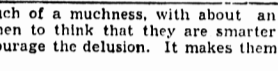
