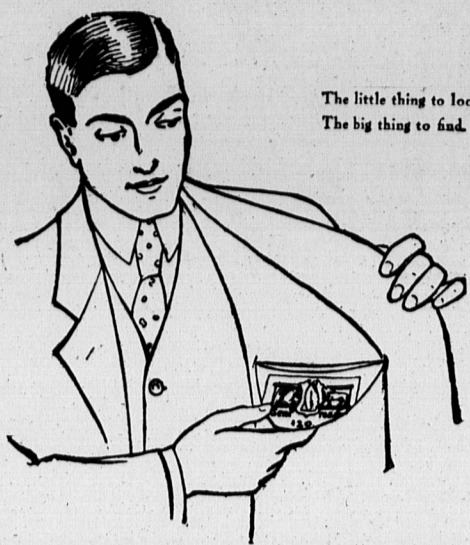

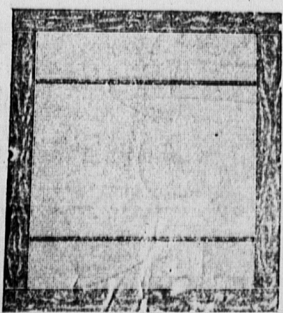

BEST COLLECTION OF MEDALS IN THE WORLD.

OTTAWA, June 2—The world's best collection of medals struck during a given period has been placed in the Archives building. It is the gift of the British Government to Canada and comprises a copy of every medal issued during the reign of Queen Victoria.

There are 214 medals in the collection, some of them gold; some of them silver and some bronze. With the medals there are also the clasps and apart from the sentimental value of them, the intrinsic worth is several thousand dollars. One gold medal alone represents about \$300.

The collection is described by Dr. Doughty, Dominion Archivist, as the best collection in the world. They provide an interesting study, especially interest for the Crimean war medals, emblems of the great campaign side by side with France against Russia, there is the Victoria Cross, which the war heroes of the Empire wear. There are the medals of the Indian wars, the Sudan, South Africa, and the other small engagements in which men of the Empire have taken part.

Those who are interested in Canada's part in the cause of Great Britain will find of peculiar interest those medals which the 100th Canadian Regiment, the Nile Voyageurs, the South African contingents and others won.

The collection forms a brief summary of the war struggles of Britain during the long reign of Queen Victoria.

Of course there are other emblems, those awarded to heroes in the private walks of life, which are no less interesting.

NEW YORK, June 4—The "old fashioned fourth of July" that New York is to have this year will be new fangled in one particular, at least, Mayor Gaynor announced today that the city will not pay the bills. "This celebration will be by the people or not at all," he said at a meeting of the committee appointed by him to formulate plans.

IS CONVICTED OF BIGAMY.

SYDNEY, June 4—The June term of the Supreme Court will be opened here next week by Judge Longley. There are only a small number of cases on the docket this term, and it is likely the court will finish by the end of the week.

The County Court adjourned yesterday afternoon. Before the adjournment, Judge Finlayson sentenced Adeline Redmond, charged with bigamy, to two years in Dorchester. The first husband of the lady, Felix Polimina, is now serving a term of nine years in the penitentiary for shooting a man at the coke ovens about a year ago. The second man whom she married on May 2nd, named John Walker, was convicted of stealing a sum of money about a week ago, from a boarder, and yesterday was sentenced by Judge Finlayson to two years in Dorchester. The woman now goes to join the men she married, at the penitentiary.

ANGRY WITH ROOSEVELT.

GENEVA, June 6—The Young Egyptian Committee has issued a violent protest against the sentiments expressed by Roosevelt in his speech in London in which the former President expressed the opinion that Great Britain should show a firmer hand in Egypt.

The Committee declares the speech an insult, not only to Europe and Egypt, but to the whole civilized world.

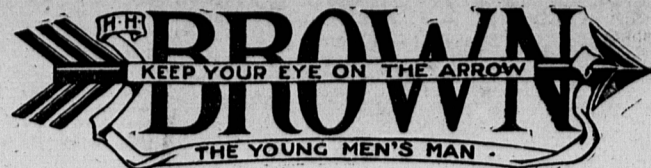
