SUGGESTIONS.

The letter of C. W. Hall, which will be found elsewhere in this paper, will be read with interest by many former acquaintances of the writer and perhaps with some heart-searchings by those who have given the tourist question any consideration.

Unquestionably the tourist business, if developed, would be a revenue-producing source for this province, and that it could be greatly developed will not be doubted. We have the first great essentials for a tourist trade, a climate unique in its healthfulness and restfulness, sea bathing, fishing, driving, boating, etc.

In other words, we have the goods. We want the customers. Now there are two sides to a trade question, the side of the trader and that of the customer. Each wants his own. While the one gives and the other receives what each is satisfied to call good value the trade will prosper. When either gets beyond that point trouble begins and business declines. The store that charges too much for its goods, that takes advantage of a customer, soon goes out of business. On the other hand, the customer who demands too much, who is looking for "something for nothing," is not wanted in any store. These conditions are to be found in the tourist business. It is quite possible that in our catering we have demanded too much of our customers. The license fees for fishing and shooting may, as Mr. Hall suggests, be out of proportion to the game and fish available; it is possible that more suitable arrangements could be made than granting licenses for a full season when only part of the season is available. These are matters over which the Fish and Game Protection Association exercises jurisdiction.

In connection with the complaint of a traveller who recently visited Summerside we might say that the advisability of gleaming too closely in any case is questionable. ly workers for the farms. We don't want people for Western Canada only; we need them for the East. We are going to see the ten-acre farm in Eastern Canada; and land is becoming so dear in parts of Western Canada that the problem of locating immigrants there has changed. The result of continued settlement in Canada will be to force intensive farming." This is the kind of agricultural teaching needed in Canada and nowhere more than in Prince Edward Island.

The latest "ritual murder" case in Kiev has provoked a notable protest in England, which has been signed by most of the principal dons of Oxford, Cambridge, and other universities, by many eminent fellows of the Royal Society, many eminent statesmen, and a number of distinguished writers and artists. It says: "The 'Blood Accusation' is a relic of the days of Witchcraft and Black Magic, a cruel and utterly baseless libel on Judaism, an insult to Western culture, and a dishonor to the churches in whose name it has been falsely formulated by ignorant fanatics. Religious minorities other than the Jews, such as the early Christians, the Quakers, and Christian missionaries in China, have been victimized by it. It has been denounced by the best men of all ages and creeds; the Popes, the Founders of the Reformation, the Khalif of Islam, statesmen of every country, together with all the great seats of learning in Europe, have publicly repudiated it. It is the more necessary that these testimonies should be renewed because among the ignorant and inflammable populace of eastern Europe, the 'Blood Accusation' has often given rise to terrible outbreaks of mob violence against the Jews, and there is grave reason to fear that its present resuscitation may endanger many innocent lives in the crowded Jewries of the Russian Empire."

HALFPENNY IN POLE VAULT.

STOCKHOLM, July 11—The pole-vaulting and semi-final heats of the 200 metre flat race proceed simultaneously and the results of both gave the American team every reason for satisfaction.

There were twenty-one competitors in the pole-vault, in which all clearing three metres 65 centimeters (12 feet) qualified for the final. Eight of the United States teams participated, these being Frank T. Nelson, Yale University; Harry S. Babcock, Columbia University; G. B. Dukes, New York Athletic Club; Mark S. Wright, Dartmouth; Frank D. Murphy, University of Illinois; S. H. Bellah, Multnomah Athletic Club; Frank J. Coyle, University of Chicago, and W. H. Fritz, Cornell University. All of these qualified for final. The only three of the other nationalities left in are W. Halppenny, Canada; R. Pasemann, German, and B. Uggia, Sweden.
