Russian Duma Has Warm Session

Cruelty and Torture on Part of Policemen Warmly Discussed in Lower House - Bribery Charges Result in a Challenge to a Duel.

St. Petersburg, May 31.—(Special)—The Lower House of Parliament yesterday declared an unambiguous resolution in the matter of torture inflicted upon the prisoners at Riga, and consequently the affair will be submitted to the Emperor. In the course of the day the Minister of Justice declared that officials of his department had taken any part in the proceedings, as had been charged, and declared that information of the Duma Committee in this respect was absolutely untrue. M. Makaroff, Assistant Minister of Interior, then declared that the police had been guilty of inflicting torture. He said preliminary inquiry had shown that 14,000 cases of police brutality had been reported. A total of forty-two police officials had been arraigned on charges. He did not wish to justify their conduct, but under the existing abominable conditions, the actions of the police might be excused by the cruelty of the revolutionaries. It could not be expected that the police always should remain calm when more than ten thousand of their comrades had been killed or wounded in the Baltic Provinces. Numerous resolutions for this against the Government having been requested, the House finally adopted a resolution declaring the explanations of the Government to be unsatisfactory. The debate on the answer of the Government to the interpellation concerning the matiny in Riga, April 13, when seven officers were killed and twelve wounded was then continued. The matter last came up in the house on April 21. The Minister of Justice, M. Chibogolovitch, denied that the medical officers had been inflicted in the mutiny, but admitted they had been beaten with Cossack whips and subjected to the most brutal treatment today, Count Bobrinsky, monarchist, who had been charged with bribery in connection with the elections in Tall, accused the floor on a question of privilege and accused E. I. Rodichoff, constitutional Democrat, of falsehood, at the same time.

WARM WELCOME FOR THE DUKE

OTTAWA, May 31.—The Duke D'Albrouzzi will arrive at Quebec with the fleet of Italian warships in command, but June 23, and will begin a tour of the principal cities of Canada. This means that Canada will have two royal foreign guests at one time, for the Prince of Wales, of Japan, will be receiving the hospitality of Vancouver when the Duke D'Albrouzzi is being saluted at Quebec. While the Italian Prince is not coming to Canada on an official mission such as that on which he went to the United States, where he represented Italy at the Jamestown Exhibition, he is a personage of sufficient importance for any country to treat with a good deal of ceremony, particularly when he comes with a guard of warships. Therefore wherever he goes in Canada, he will be received as a member of the Royal Family of Italy, and as the representative of that country with which Canada would be glad to have improved commercial relations. Unless he signifies his desire for a quiet life he will be received with as much ceremony as Prince Pashian.
