SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON

THIRD QUARTER. WORDS AND WORKS OF JESUS AS RECORDED IN THE GOSPELS. LESSON VIII.—AUGUST 10. THE JUDGE, THE PHARISEE, AND THE PUBLICAN.

Luke 18, 1-14. Memorize verses 13, 14. GOLDEN TEXT.

God be merciful to me a sinner.—Luke 18, 13. Theme.—Early spring, A.D. 30. Place.—Perea.

EXPLANATION.

1. "A parable . . . that men ought always to pray"—Only here and in verse 9 have we an explanation of the point of a parable preceding the parable itself. "And not to faint"—The word translated "faint" means to give in through cowardice or faint-heartedness. The same word is used by Paul in 2 Cor. 4, 1 and 16, and in Gal. 6, 9.

2. "In a city"—Rather, "a certain city." "A judge"—Doubtless a Gentile official, "which feared not God, neither regarded man"—If he was a Roman it would be natural for him to defy both the God of the Hebrews and public opinion, at least in minor decisions.

3. "A widow"—Typical of defencelessness. "Came"—Literally, "kept on coming." "Avenge me of"—Rather, "Give me a sentence of protection against;" that is, settle my case and relieve me of further oppression.

4. "And the Lord said"—A clause inculcating a pause during which the people addressed had time to consider the parable. Whereupon Jesus adds this comment and emphasizes the moral of the narrative. "Hear what the unjust judge at h"—In the sense of "Hear what even an unrighteous judge is constrained to say from selfish motives."

5. "Shall not God avenge (relieve and protect) his (own) elect which cry day and night (unto him), though he bear long with them?"—The question at the beginning of this verse is the intensive form and anticipates an affirmative answer. The argument of the verse is simply, If an unrighteous judge from selfish motives would yield to the importunity of an unknown widow, who at intervals repeated her petition before him, how much more will a just and compassionate God respond to the daily (habitual) prayer of his children?

6. "I tell you that he will avenge them speedily"—Actually, even if not apparently, "Shall he find faith"—Literally, "the faith;" that is, a special, necessary faith. We might even translate, "his faith," that is, the faith in God which confidently expects his answer, and therefore which recognizes and accepts the Son of man, the Messiah and Saviour, when he cometh.

7. "Certain which trusted in themselves that they were righteous"—These were certainly typical of many among those present.

8. "A publican"—A tax collector, appointed by Gentile authorities to collect the revenue from a certain province or district.

9. "Not as other men are"—It is just possible that the Pharisee was in reality all that he professed not to be. Of his class Jesus once said, "Ye strain out the gnat and swallow the camel." While observing the letter of the law they disregarded utterly its spirit.

10. "Tithes of all that I possess"—He tithed his income, not his capital.

11. "Far off"—That is, far from the Pharisee, not from the place of worship.

12. "I tell you, this man (the publican) went down to his house justified rather than the other (the Pharisee)"—The word "justified," means "accounted as right, or accepted." It refers to the judicial verdict of God as judge of the two men.

QUESTIONS ON THE LESSON.

What necessity or propriety was there in our Lord's speaking three parables of warning just after the three parables of grace in which the mercy and forgiveness of the heavenly Father had been emphasized? What points and teachings are common to the two parables of our lesson? On what aspect of prayer does each lay special stress? What was it in each which won for him forgiveness and justification?

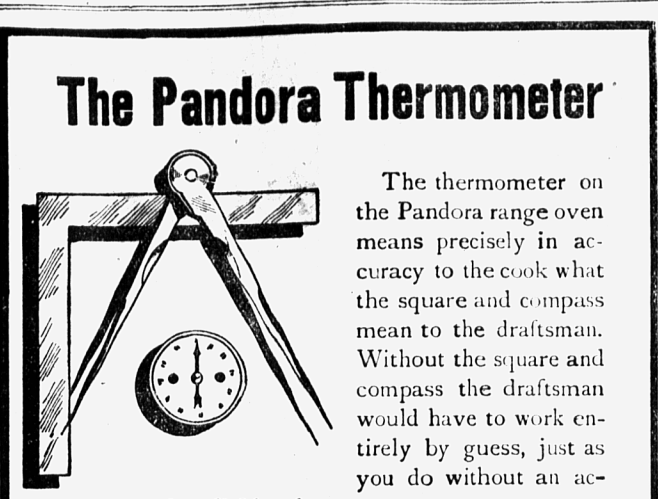
Calendar table showing moon phases, day of week, sun, moon, high water, etc.

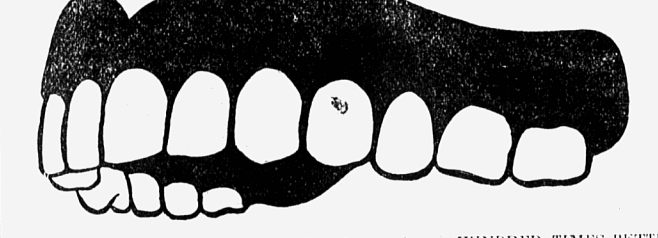

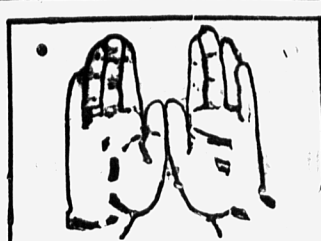
