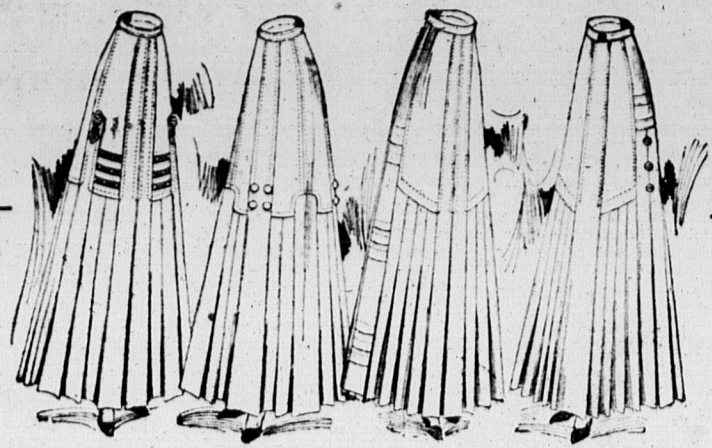

AN OPEN LETTER TO THE BOARD OF HEALTH.

Scarlet fever was reported as existing in a house on Gerald Street March 1st, 1910. The house was flagged according to custom, and the tenant notified that he could not attend to his work and at the same time remain at home the non-working hours; he being employed in connection with a dry goods store, and delivering parcels to houses all over the city, as this would tend to a very extensive spread of the disease.

In the house were ten inmates, seven being young children, the sick child being only three years old.

The patient's room was quarantined, and, after several days, there being no new case breaking out, steps were taken to remove the father to another house so he could attend again to his work.

To do this it became necessary to have one of the children assist in nursing, and a girl of twelve, who was thought to have had the disease, was allowed in the room.

Unfortunately this girl became seriously sick with scarlet fever, and is yet very ill.

This made it necessary for the father to still remain at home to attend to the other members of his family, his wife having more than she could attend to in caring for the sick children.

This family is a very poor one, and the father can get no credit.

Under these circumstances, I, as Health Officer, directed the Sanitary Officer to provide the necessary food for them during their sickness. I notified B. Rogers, Jr., the chair-

man of the Board of Health, of my work in connection with this case. He, it seems, instructed the Sanitary Officer not to purchase any such supplies, as the city would not pay for them.

As these people could not be allowed to starve, even to suit the Mayor, the Sanitary Officer was told by me to get what was necessary, and if the Board of Health decided that I had not done right in the matter, I would pay the bills myself.

Yesterday morning, on going into the Clerk's Office, I found the bill for these necessities, marked by some one "not ordered by the City," and I then wrote the Mayor, who is chairman of the Board of Health, who was in the adjoining room, a note asking him to call a meeting of the Board of Health for that evening, as there was a special meeting of the council.

At the conclusion of the special meeting, which was over at 8:20 p. m., I asked him about the meeting and he said it was not necessary. I then asked him again about providing for this family, and he said they would get nothing as he would not allow any lazy fellows to be fed off the city.

Then I told him we could not persist in quarantining a man who was unable to live without working, unless we provided him with food, and asked him if we should relieve the man from his enforced idleness.

His answer was, "You must take the responsibility of that," to which I replied that he'd have to get some one else to take the responsibility where I was not allowed any way of carrying out the orders. He then said, "You can resign if you like," and I at once wrote out my resignation and handed it to the Clerk.

Under these circumstances, having been refused a meeting of the Board of Health, I take the only other way of getting the information before you, as I would like to know what the Board of Health intends to do.

I have certified to bills for necessities for this family, amounting to almost ten cents a day for each member. It is certainly not an excessive amount, and I doubt if the Mayor, financier though he may be, could do better for the city in this matter than Sergeant Bradley did.

We cannot quarantine poor people and allow them to starve, though the Mayor may think it quite a correct thing to do. They must either be fed or allowed to go free to earn food.

While acting as Health Officer for Charlottetown under the preceding Mayor, my efforts were all given in the interests of the city, and the chairman of the Board always was anxious to have the most thorough work done, with results that are shown in the statistics of our city. How long our statistics will remain so good will rest on the action of the Board of Health, which cannot afford to play at their business, though their chairman does not think it worth while consulting them in health matters.
