**THE PROHIBITION LAW.**—According to a proclamation appearing in the Royal Gazette, Section 52 of the Prohibition Act, which has been held in suspense since the passing of the Measure, became operative on Saturday. It provides that no person shall have in his possession, any liquor unless it has been purchased from a Vendor and a Vendor's label is on the bottle. Any person who has such liquor in his house or in his possession will be guilty of the violation of the Prohibition Act, and punished accordingly. This section however, does not apply to wine for sacramental purposes, provided it has been obtained in a legal manner, nor shall not apply to alcohol in the possession of a drug gist, or a package under seal or to which a permit has been attached.


