PRISON AND FINE FOR TAKING BRIBE.

REGINA, Sask., Nov. 2.—Terbert C. Pierce, Liberal member of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan for Wadena, was sentenced today to twelve months imprisonment without hard labor in Regina jail and to pay a fine of \$55, or in default serve an additional six months in jail.

Pierce at the last sitting of the Supreme Court was found guilty by a jury on a charge of having received a bribe from the Saskatchewan Licensed Victuallers' Association for his influence in having temperance legislation to abolish the bar to be withdrawn from the House in 1913.

The Chief Justice asked the prisoner if he had anything to say why sentence should not be passed on him. "Nothing, Your Lordship, except that I am innocent," replied Pierce. Sir Frederick addressed a few words to Pierce, pointing out to him the seriousness of the offence of which he had been found guilty.

GIRL'S NECK BROKEN, BUT SHE RECOVERS.

BROCKTON, Nov. 6.—Marie L. Hayes, aged 11, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Austin J. Hayes, of Laureston and Shepard streets, has been discharged from a Boston hospital. Her neck was broken last August when she fell. She still wears a cast about her neck, but within a few weeks this will be removed. When she was admitted to the hospital it was said she could not live.

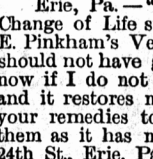
