WOO DAK SAN CHEATS CHAIR  
SANTA FE, N. M., May 1. (U. P.)—For more than five years, Woo Dak San has been under a death sentence—and yet he lives. One of the factors delaying his execution, or a reversal of the case by the Supreme Court is that in 1929 the legislature changed the mode of execution from hanging to electrocution. But since Woo Dak San was convicted and condemned March 8, 1928 when hanging was the mode of punishment, Alvan N. White, his attorney contends that to apply the new law of electrocution to his client would be an ex post facto proceeding.
