

COUNTERFEITER SENTENCED.

TORONTO, Nov. 21.—At the Police Court to-day, Gentile, alias Clemente, the Italian counterfeiter, captured here after a long chase through the United States by New York detectives, was found guilty. On the lesser charge of making foreign coins, Gentile was given the limit of three years in the penitentiary. For making Canadian coins he was sentenced to ten years, the two terms to run concurrently.

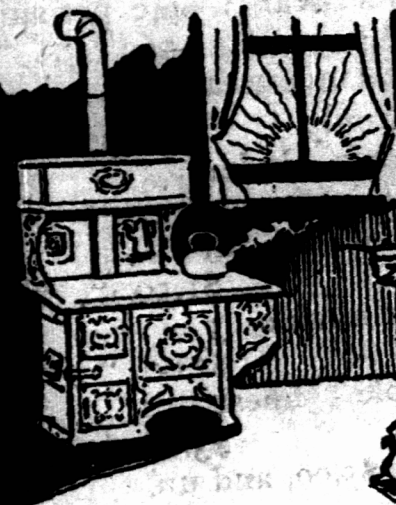
