ALMOND PASTE 3 egg whites 1 pound icing sugar 1 pound almond paste Blend egg whites, icing sugar and almond paste thoroughly. Roll out about half-inch thick and cut the exact size and shape of cake.

MERINGUES

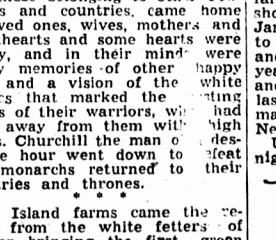
