**The Markets At A Glance**

**WINNIPEG, June 19 (CP)—**Wheat futures prices on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange fluctuated widely today, and moderate gains were scored in the early trade. These were later erased, however, by a liberal selling flurry.

**CHICAGO, June 19 (AP)—**Selling of oats by eastern interests broke the November and September contracts from their ceilings. The first few minutes of trading today, but the market recovered quickly from this surprising development and prices went back to their maximums. They remained there for the rest of the session.

**MONTREAL, June 19 (CP)—**Declines ruled again today in the stock exchange and curb market in extension of yesterday's downward trends though at the close resistance appeared to be entering transactions in spots. Market analysts said changing tendencies in New York influenced many local traders and others were ducking commitments at small losses in view of the imminence of budget day at Ottawa.

**TORONTO, June 19 (CP)—**Falling a fairly firm display in the early hours the Toronto stock exchange slipped in the late trading to chalk up index losses for all groups. The industrial index closed with an index drop of 1.51 to a new low for this year and the other groups had insignificant declines. Featuring the trade was the strong action of Sherritt-Gordon. It climbed to 83 for a gain of 30 cents on turnover of around 100,000 shares.

**NEW YORK, June 19 (AP)—**Scattered raids and industrials achieved modest comebacks in a resistance to the curb market. The Associated Press 80-stock average was off 8 of a point at 80. The industrial index was off 1.51 point and the rails unchanged. Canadian stocks showed strength at the close with Distillers Sagar up 2-3-4 and Hiram Walker up 2. Some Mines gained 1-4. Lake Shore on the curb, lost as much.
