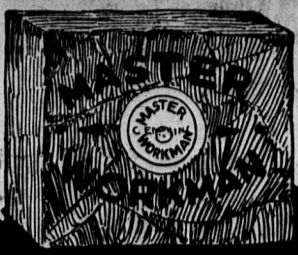

P. E. Island Cows Lead in Milk Test

The official record of the Holstein cows of Canada has just been issued. It is gratifying to find that Prince Edward Island is well represented. The two Prince Edward Island cows competing are first in their respective classes. Mr. J.

Walter Jones' two year old heifer, Lily Echo Posch, who was sweepstakes at Charlottetown Exhibition in the 1922 milk test, leads the fourteen two year olds competing with 896 1/4 pounds of butter and 19,024 pounds of milk. Her average test for the year is over 3.5. This is by far the highest record ever made in the Maritime province by any two year old of any breed. This, the Guardian is in-

formed is by no means a freak record as she carried a calf for nearly six months of the test and has just freshened with a handsome bull calf by her side which tipped the scales at 112 pounds at birth. In the three year old class, Queen Desta Abbecker owned by the Department of Agriculture, Charlottetown, leads a class of six Holstein cows with 736 1/4 pounds of butter and 21,281 pounds of milk.

These two records make a splendid advertisement for this province as the record goes broadcast over Canada and the United States. A Dog in St. Mary's County is reported to be addicted to chewing tobacco. "It's an old ss mother," remarks the Detroit News, "probably neglected him at an early age and let him associate with a man."

Recent Purchase of Valuable Stock

During the past few weeks a number of the live stock men of this province, including the Commissioner of Agriculture, purchased some valuable animals which will add to the stock of the province. When at the Royal Show in Toronto, the Commissioner of Agriculture and W. J. Reid of the Department of Agriculture purchased eight Yorkshire sows and one Yorkshire boar. They had been imported from the Earl of Rosebury's herd of Swine in Scotland by J. E. Platt of Hamilton, Ont. This is undoubtedly the most valuable purchase of swine that has ever been added to the Provincial herds. It is the intention of the Commissioner to place the most of these sows and the boar at Falconwood Farm, and the products in the form of young stock will be distributed through-

the province for the benefit of the bacon industry. Another valuable purchase made at the Royal was the aged Holstein bull, Count Rauward Rattler, by Alex. Agnew, Charlottetown. Royal Holstein breeders and live stock men in general have been made acquainted with this animal through his records in the show ring as an individual and as a sire of prize winning stock. He has stood at the head of the Kemptville Agricultural School herd at Kemptville, Ont., for a number of years, and has produced some stock that are a credit to the breed, and well merit recognition among the best. He was the mature sire at the head of the Ontario herd which secured premier position over all entries from Canada and the United States in the Dairy Cattle Congress held in Syracuse, N. Y. last season. Mr. Agnew is to be complimented on his purchase and will undoubtedly gain a just recognition for his foresight in selecting breeders.

The Golfrey Brothers of North Wiltshire have purchased an outstanding yearling Holstein bull from Dickie Brothers of Nova Scotia. This animal stood third in his class at the Royal Winter Fair in Toronto, and is the prodigee of the best records of production and show ring stock in Nova Scotia. Mr. Arthur J. McIntosh of Thornburn, N. S., has purchased the young Clydesdale stallion, Sir Baron Triumph, owned by the Provincial Department of Agriculture, and will take delivery of him on Monday, December 17. It is understood that Mr. McIntosh will use this valuable horse in the vicinity of New Glasgow, N. S., where he will undoubtedly merit recognition by the grade of stock that he will produce. When the cow is comfortable and contented, she responds with a flow of milk far in excess of that which she gives when she has been uncomfortable and irritated.

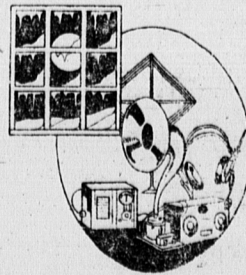
