### STEEL TRUST AS PHILANTHROPIST.

NEW YORK, April 18—Following an announcement yesterday of an increase in pay for employees of the United States Steel Corporation and its subsidiaries, estimated at \$9,000,000 annually, Elbert H. Gary, chairman of the executive committee, made public today, details of a plan for the relief of employees injured at work and the families of men killed. The plan will be put in operation May 1 for a year's test and if successful the company hopes to continue it with such modifications as experience may suggest. The cost will be several millions a year and employees do not contribute. For temporary disablement, single men will receive 35 per cent. of their wages and married men 50 per cent., with an additional five per cent. for each child under sixteen and two per cent. for each year's service above five years. For permanent injuries, lump payments are provided, based upon the extent to which the injury interferes with employment and the annual earning capacity of the victim. Where employees are killed their families will receive a sum equal to his wages for a year and a half, with an additional ten per cent. for each child under sixteen and three per cent. for each year of service above five years. Attention is called to the fact that for some years the subsidiary companies have been making payments to men injured and the families of employees who are killed, in practically all cases without regard to legal liability, aggregating about \$1,000,000 annually. The new plan, however, is expected to bring additional benefits. Legal liability, it is stated, does not enter into the new arrangement. Announcement is also made that a plan for pensioning disabled or superannuated employees is under consideration and it is expected this will soon be put into practical effect.

### LACKAWANNA TRAINMEN THREATEN TO STRIKE.

SCRANTON, Pa., April 18—M. W. Cadel, vice-president of the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers, is expected here tomorrow to endorse the ultimatum given the management of the Delaware, Lackawanna & Western Railroad by Presidents A. B. Garretson and W. G. Lee, of the Conductors and Trainmen, on behalf of the employees of that road.

Meanwhile the grand lodge men say the company officials must agree to accept the award to be handed down by the arbitrators now dealing with the New York Central employees, or a strike order will be issued calling out conductors, trainmen, engineers and firemen on the entire Lackawanna system.

### WANTS KING EDWARD TO TAKE AEROPLANE.

LONDON, April 18—As a result of the proof given the other day of his interest in the science of aviation King Edward has been asked by a certain well-known and extremely wealthy Englishman whether he will consent to accept an aeroplane as a gift. Presumably it is thought that His Majesty would like occasionally to see private experiments carried out with a flying machine belonging to himself, but, in that case, it would be necessary to have an experienced aeronaut at his disposal. The proposed gift is hardly likely to be accepted, more particularly as the King does not appreciate offers of this kind from persons who for various reasons, as in the present instance, are open to the suspicion of being anxious to curry favor in high places. The man of money may, therefore, prepare himself for a polite, but definite refusal.

PARIS, April 19.—In the opening of the International White Slave Conference, Mr. Finchon, the foreign Minister, urged the adoption of a complete and definitive agreement for the suppression of the White Slave Traffic and the circulation of obscene literature.

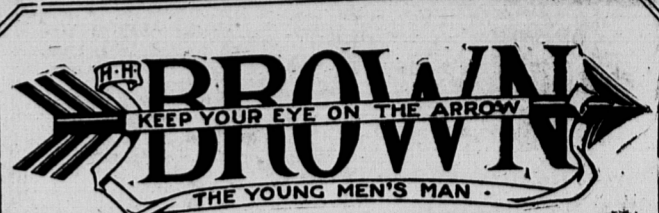

On nearly all lawns there are unsightly bare spots under the shade of trees, which have baffled all efforts to get into grass, but with this mixture there need be no further difficulty. It is a combination of fine, dwarf-growing, evergreen varieties, hardy, and will stand a long season of dry weather. The ground for a new lawn should be a rich mellow soil, perfectly free from weeds. Sow the Seeds as early in the spring as possible, roll the ground perfectly level; the grass should be cut often, and never allowed to attain a length of over three inches.
