ORIGIN OF THE MARSEILLAISE.

It was in the night of April 25, 1792, when war against Austria had just been declared, that Rouget de Lisle, then a captain in the Strassburg Garrison, wrote: "The Marseillaise," which he entitled:—"War Song of the Army of the Rhine." It was sung by Mireux, the deputy for Montpellier, who had accompanied some local volunteers at a banquet given them at Marseilles by volunteers belonging to that town, and so it was called "The Marseillaise," whereas the name "Strassbourgeoise" would have been more correct. The last verse, which is the best known after the first, was composed by the poet Louis Dubois for the civic festival of October 14, 1792.

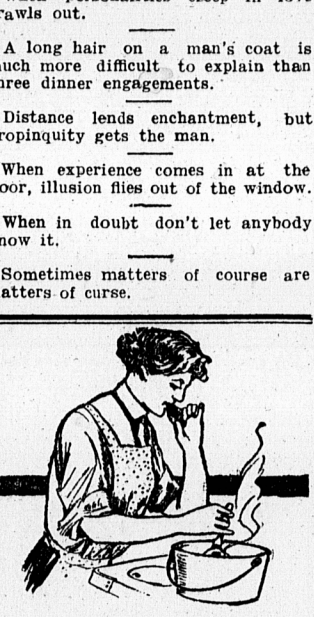
