FOREST FIRES ARE DEVASTATING ALBERTA.
EDMONTON, July 22.—Fire which has been raging for several days and is still burning furiously, according to F. P. Watson, of this city, is devastating all that country between Tetejaum Cache and Jasper, the latter better known by the old name of Pithouge. The forest fire, which has been seen by many people travelling over the Grand Trunk Pacific railway, is said to be some ten miles in length and approximately two miles wide. It is travelling at a great speed, and if not checked promises to involve loss of life. In the vicinity of the Nac acho river, the fire is said to be at its height.

PRICE OF BINDER TWINE SUPPLIES MAY BE RAISED

WINNIPEG, Man., July 21.—According to the officials of the Grain Growers' Association, who have been conducting an investigation into the annual question of binder twine supplies, the manufacturers have formed a corner in the raw material and the monopoly is now so complete that a general order to raise the price may be made at any moment. The investigation was the outcome of an attempt by R. J. MacKenzie, secretary of the Grain Growers Grain Company to secure information as to the possibility of starting a British company to fight the United States manufacturers. But British capitalists pointed out that manufacturers had a monopoly of the raw material, and the project was futile. The investigation, however, resulted in attention being directed to the manufacture of the twine from flax straw, thousands of tons of which are burned in Canada every year.
