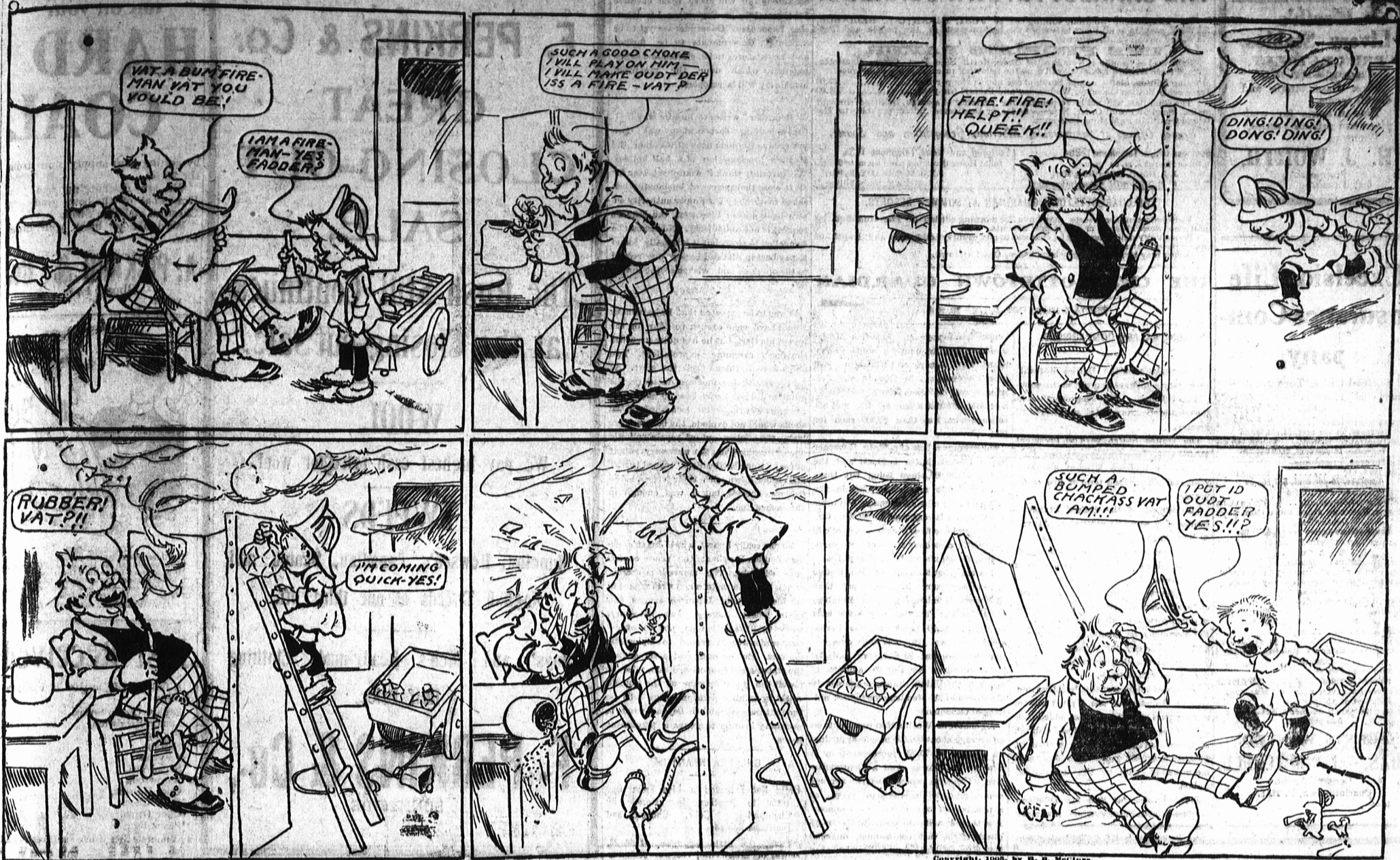

DEAR EDITOR.—I feel I must write and let you know how much I appreciate your grand editorials, especially those in reference to that salary grab or steal. Our Government will soon be as bad as the Russian Government if a lot of unscrupulous politicians are allowed to vote themselves half a million dollars whenever they think fit. I think Canada is the most over-governed country in the world. There's enough government machinery for about five million law-abiding people to govern 100,000,000 of half savages.

But what matter, as long as it makes fat offices for lazy officials who do nothing, while the poor farmer who toils from ten to fifteen hours a day for a bare living is bled to death to pay his big salary. This country should be proud of a paper like The Guardian that is not bribed or muzzled by any party, but at all times stands for truth and righteousness. For three years I had the best Boston and New York dailies and your paper was the equal, if not the superior of them in appearance and general make-up. Last week you wrote of the cement manufacturer wanting more duty on that article. How is it that when I lived in Boston I bought hundreds of barrels of Portland cement for one dollar and 20 cents retail and Rosendale (another good cement) for one dollar per barrel? And they charge three dollars here. If a farmer could yet cement at an honest price he could have water-tight floors in his stables and in that way save the most valuable half of the manure; but no, protect the dear manufacturers for they are the ones who will furnish the hodge for bogus ballot boxes and other election dodges.

OVERHAULING MINING DISPLAY.

OTTAWA, July 24.—The mining display in the Imperial Institute, London, will be overhauled by the government this year. The exhibit, which is supposed to be a permanent advertisement for Canada, is maintained at a cost of about \$8,000 a year. Some of the recently discovered Canadian minerals are not represented, and it is the intention to spend some \$2,000 on making the mineral specimens an adequate representation of the valuable mining resources of Canada.
