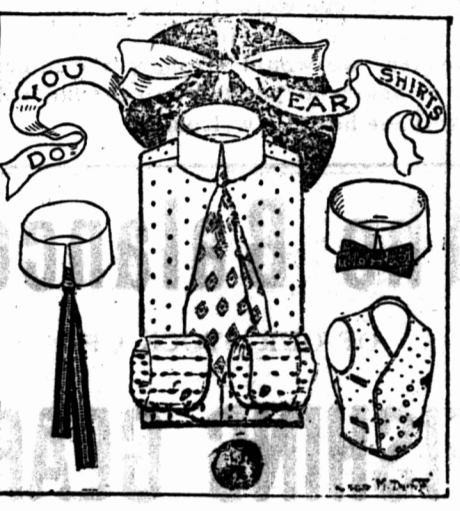
THE CLUMSY MAN.
