The marriage took place on Monday last at the Methodist parsonage, Summerside by Rev. Hammond Johnson, of Russel Shaw of Sherbrooke to Miss Margaret Raynon of Travelers Rest.

Yesterday the issue of Summerside Water and Sewerage debentures to the amount of \$1,800,000 were signed and delivered by the town to the Bank of Nova Scotia who are acting in the matter for the purchaser, Dominion Securities Company Montreal.

In the Supreme Court of Summerside yesterday the case of William Gray, son and Co. Ltd., vs W. B. Bowness, on action for debt was tried before the chief justice and a jury who brought in a verdict for the defendant. McQuarrie K. C., for the plaintiff Saunders for defendant. In the case of E. Pineau vs Dr. James McDonald, an action for labor performed the chief justice found a verdict for the plaintiff for \$46. Strong and Saunders for the plaintiff, McQuarrie, K. C., for defendant.

Pursuant to notice a commission composed of A. E. McWilliams, Coleman, chairman, W. C. McNeill, Elmsdale, and Peter Gaudet, St. Anthony's, appeared before the residents of Casumpec and Fortune Cove, respectively, on the 13th inst in Casumpec Schoolroom, to hear and enquire into the matter of the Ferry Road, leading to Mill River, of which a petition running through James W. Clark's farm, was closed by the Government three years ago and duly published in Royal Gazette, after petition had been sent in asking them to have it closed. Petitions were sent in afterwards, praying for the reopening of same, as the road is promising to become a benefit to the public in general. Thus the above mentioned gentlemen were commissioned by the Executive Council, to act on the matter and report. The following farmers, C. W. Clark, James C. Hudson, Dominic Arsenault, Miner Bridges, J. J. Rayner and Silas Gamble, all spoke in favor of having road reopened at once. W. C. McNeill presented a resolution embodying the grievances of the residents, such as a hindrance to mud hauling, sea weeded privileges, fisherman, and traveling public in general, and a resolution carried unanimously. A resolution was presented strongly protesting against any indemnity, being paid to James W. Clark for re-opening of said road, as he paid no money into the public treasury for same, and was not entitled to any recompense on that account. Also put to meeting and carried unanimously. On motion it was resolved to have report for publication. J. Hughes Bryan acted in the capacity of chairman and the undersigned as secretary, R. H. Rayner.
