JANUARY 9.
BAPTISM AND TEMPTATION OF
JESUS.
Matt. 3:13-17. 4:1-11.
GOLDEN TEXT.

"In that He himself hath suffered, being tempted, He is able to succour them that are tempted."—Heb. 2:18.

POINTED SUGGESTIONS.

Jesus numbers Himself with the transgressors by submitting to, and, indeed, requesting a baptism which was a confession of sin, and which was utterly unnecessary. As a mother she was the mother of her prodigal boy for wayward girl, though her personal conduct is above suspicion or reproach, so it would appear that the consciousness of the sins of men whom He came to redeem so shadowed the spirit of Jesus that He sought the baptism of cleansing which they needed, while He consecrated Himself to fulfil all righteousness.

The humiliation of the manger cradle, of which the babe Jesus was unconsciously, while thus from the unstable heaven He became manifest in the flesh, was a humiliation which was voluntarily taken when upon the threshold of His sacrificial ministry and borne with unwavering willingness until His death upon the Cross. He became poor.

But His humiliation into the place of the sinful was His exaltation. The Spirit descended upon Him and He came in fullness His indwelling Guest, so that from the hour that the amazed John the Baptist granted the request of the Sinless One for a sinner's baptism, it was evident to all that the Man of Nazareth went about, even as He went into the wilderness, led by the Spirit. When the character is sealed and set in holiness it is pledged to victory. One day it shall be able to say: "I glorified Thee on the earth, having accomplished the work which Thou hast given me to do."

While that is so the devil does not seem to be aware of it. None are exempt from his strategic endeavors. He is prepared to try conclusions with Jesus. And it has to be confessed that the subtlety of man's adversary makes him a foe to be feared. The exhortation which warns men to beware of the wiles of the devil is made clamorous and clamant by the woeful experience of thousands who have been snared and taken.

When Jesus was in solitude and when He hungered from long fasting as He pondered and prayed and prepared His soul to meet the problem of His Messiahship, the devil tempted Him. It was after the vigil and the fasting, and at the moment of the flesh weariness of Jesus, that he came. It was the time to strike if any time was vulnerable. He lay in waiting for this hour.

And he had three successive propositions to present of most plausible intent. They were presented to Jesus certain methods of success. The devil did not seek to break down or divert the thought of Jesus from the mighty work for which He was born. On the other hand he suggested ways and means of a sure accomplishment. It is not often that a man's business or calling is at fault. The devil in him is seen in the way he goes about his business. The wily old foe does not care how many preachers there are or Sunday School teachers or scholars, so long as they will take pointers from him as to how to preach and teach and live.

But Jesus Christ cannot be led in to any false or God-dishonoring or God-tempting methods. And He defeats the enemy of malicious suggestion by a definite appeal to the drill-book of conduct and character. He uses upon His foe the sword of the Spirit—the word of God. When the drill-book is known, the sword is found.

The devil left Jesus. And angels succoured Him. That was a splendid exchange. Where were the angels while the devil was in evidence? They do not harbor at the same port. The word of God is sufficient to make exit for the one and entrance for the other wherever in God's providence the lot of any man is cast.—Onward.

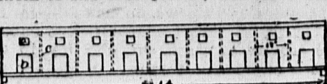

POULTRY AND BEEES

NEST FOR HENS AND CHICKS.

Plan for Keeping the Chickens Separated While Laying and Sitting.

I have a set of nests for sitting hens that is cheap and keeps each hen where she belongs, says a writer in Farm and Home. Take two 12-inch boards 14 feet long for bottom and nail them to 2x4 crosspieces, to raise it off



the ground. Then two 12-inch boards 14 feet long for front and one for the back. Make partitions, C, every 18 inches. Put on a top like a lid, as shown at D, with three hinges on front side, so it can be raised from the back. Cover the top with tin or roofing paper. Cut a hole, B, in front of each division seven inches square for hen to enter, and put the doors on hinges. Also cut a hole, A, in top of each place four-inch square for ventilation, and hinge so it will drop down. Nail screen over top hole on inside, so when left open at night nothing can get in. Set it under a shed in early spring or out of doors as the season advances and set the hens in it. When they hatch remove the old nest, tack a lath across the opening, B, to confine the hen, and you have an ideal coop for the young chicks.

BEEES STIMULATED BY FEED.
Nothing of More Vital Importance in Securing Satisfactory Surplus Than Healthy Colony.

There is probably nothing of more vital importance in securing a satisfactory surplus than having populous, healthy colonies at the opening of the flow, says a writer in Farm and Home. A strong colony will easily store twice the surplus of a medium one, and a weak colony during harvest is merely an ornament to the apiary. If the flow is late and some honey has been coming in regularly most colonies should, perhaps, of themselves build up and be ready for honey gathering. Should, however, the flow come early and outside conditions be unfavorable for

THE BEES ARE SHORT LIVED.

The Life of This Industrious Little Worker is Placed at One Month.

The life of a working bee is but a month, so at the end of winter the old bees rapidly die from old age. Various means are used to secure a force of young bees, such as spreading and equalizing brood, etc. Judicious stimulative feeding is safer and more reliable than all the rest, says a writer in Farm and Home. With a young, vigorous queen, a colony reduced to a mere handful can usually by this method be built up in an amazingly short time.

Stirring up the bees during early spring is always a heavy drain upon their energies and to avoid doing so the feeding should be done at night. If the weather be chilly the feed should be given warm. Do not attempt to feed during the day. Once stimulative feeding is begun three must be no stops till the weather becomes warm and settled and honey is coming in regularly. Erratic feeding is decidedly unprofitable.

The Cause of Limberneck. Limberneck with chickens is caused by the birds eating decaying flesh or filth containing maggots. The maggots lodge in the throats of the birds, causing paralysis of the muscles of the neck and consequent inability to swallow food. When affected, the chicken remains inactive in one place for days at a time, without control of its neck or head. Since there is no longer power to take food or drink, it gradually dies of starvation and perhaps slow poisoning. Very few that become afflicted ever recover.

Not much can be done with a chicken suffering with limberneck. Soft bread soaked with turpentine or kerosene is said to be effective in removing the cause, if the case is taken in time.

The cause of numerous diseases, and discommodable habits, heretofore ascribed to constitutional, have been traced directly to the teeth. Prolapsed, decayed, protruding, loose, weak, eyes, arising on one side and pulling are very often due to diseased and protruding teeth. The edges and sharp corners of the teeth lacerate the mouth, and produce nervousness and irritability; uneven and elongated molars and incisors prevent the proper mastication of the food, producing indigestion and general debility. Diseased and decayed teeth should be removed by extraction or by planing sharp corners and edges should be smoothed down, and elongated and uneven molars and incisors cut off. The non-removal of diseased teeth is deemed sufficient to accomplish this, will not suffice but special instruments devised for the purpose are necessary.
