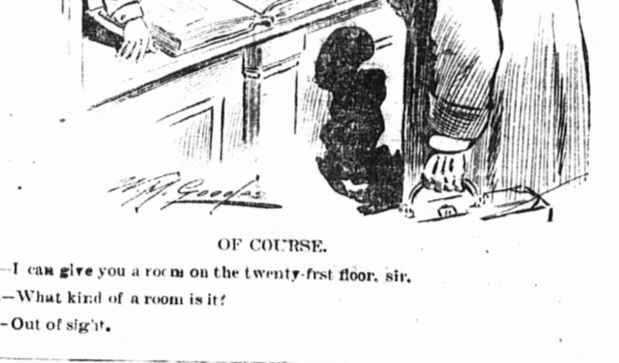

A LABOR ENTERPRISE.

Mining and industrial circles generally in the United Kingdom are intensely watching a co-operative experiment which is being tried in slate quarrying in the neighborhood of Lord Pontrhy's famous quarries in Wales. So universal is the interest in this undertaking that the necessary working capital has been provided by the labor organizations of the entire country. They have now subscribed \$126,529, which sum, it is expected, will soon be increased.

The importance of this experiment appears in the question asked: "If co-operative slate quarrying can be made a commercial success, why not have co-operative coal mines, cotton mills, iron and steel foundries, woolen manufacturers—in brief, co-operation in every industry, employing a large number of hands?"

Leaders of the movement profess to see in its success the "emancipation of labor from the bondage of capital." The glowing accounts of the balance sheet brought by trade union delegates who have visited the quarries have given rise to visions of world wealth in this departure. One result is that prospectors thronged the mountains of North Wales during the past summer, and owners of small quarries were approached with offers of purchase, this with a view to forming additional companies on the basis of the original one.
