LEBES ISLAND IS NOW REPORTED AS CAPTURED

(Canadian Press.)

WASHINGTON, May 11.—The Chile Peace Negotiations are making time pending the formal sitting of the South American Mediator to begin Monday on Canadian soil. The Mediators and Officials of the State Department here are busy on several serious phases of the situation. Secretary Bryan called at the Argentine Legation late this afternoon and spent two hours in consultation with the South American Envoy. Federal

also reported the seizure of Lebes Island with the Lighthouse by American Torpedo Boats and the case of Vera Cruz for firing upon United States sailors and Marines. Bryan insisted that the release of Shillman be brought about at once but refused to say what would happen if this was not done. As to the Lebes Island incident the Secretary informed the Mediators that so far the United States Government received no intimation of the taking of

the Island and in the absence of confirmation could offer no explanation of the reported action of the navy. In administrative circles it is contended that if the seizure had been made it would not be taken as an act of aggression against Huerta but merely a necessary step to protect shipping against the result of closing the Lighthouse by Federalists. It is still certain that Carranza and the Mexican Rebels who seek to overthrow Huerta will not be represented in the Peace Conference.

MAORI CHIEFS ON THEIR WAY TO SEE KING.

MONTREAL, May 9.—Three Maori chiefs, Terata Mahuta, Mita Karuka, and Tupu Taingakawa, chaperoned by George C. Paul, an agent of the British government, arrived in Montreal yesterday morning on their way to see the Great White King in England.

This is the first occasion that any of the three has left New Zealand and they still declare that Auckland with its population of thirty thousand is the largest city in the world. The party leaves tomorrow for the Megantic. The chiefs will proceed to London where they will be received by King George and present their grievances.
