A POLITICAL QUINTETTE.

Closely following the announcement of Sir Wilfrid Laurier's political tour in Ontario next September comes the answer that Mr. Borden will in the same month take the field in the big Province, supported by four lieutenants who are Premiers of Provinces.

Sir Wilfrid is astute, diplomatic, eloquent, a man of sunny ways and persuasive speech. But in Ontario, though he has hosts of friends there they are in the minority and he will be to some extent on the defensive.

The Guardian has received a flaming poster two by three feet in size, printed in red and black, and entitled "Facts for farmers, manufacturers, dealers, insurance agents transportation companies and wage earners."

They call upon the farmers, workmen &c. to assert their rights and put forth every effort to suppress "the growing evil of prohibition" which they say is "jeopardising the livelihood of upwards of half a million people and threatens to precipitate the greatest financial crisis this country has ever known."

Is there want in Canada—"thousands clamoring for food and shelter"? The liquor trade is responsible for more want and destitution than all other causes combined.

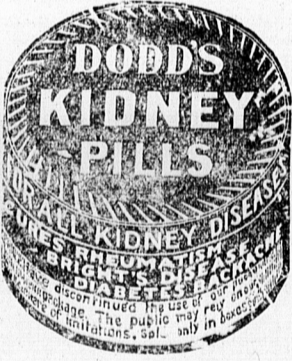

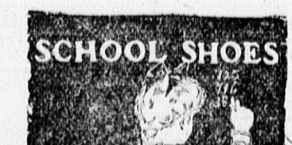
